HARRISBURG — Placements of broiler chicks in the Commonwealth during the week ending July were 2,158,000 according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

The placements were three percent below the previous week and three percent below the corresponding week a year earlier. Average placements during the past nine weeks were slightly below a year earlier.

Placements in the 21 key poultry producing states were 78,217,000, three percent below the previous week but two percent above the same period a year earlier. Average placements during the past nine weeks were two percent below a year ago.

Broiler-fryers slaughtered in Pennsylvania under federal inspection during the week ending July 2 totaled 1,966,000, with an average liveweight of 4.09 pounds.
