Berks Fashion review names winners

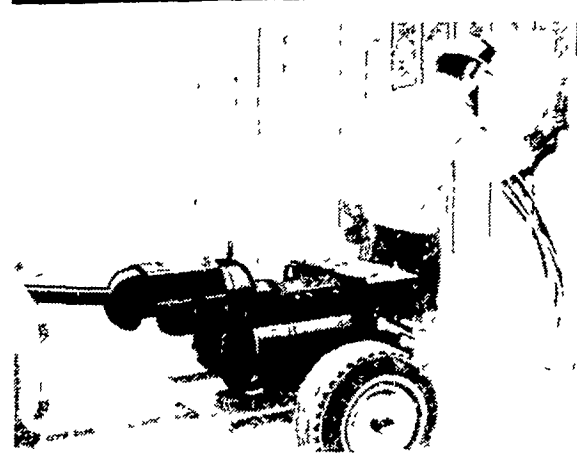
