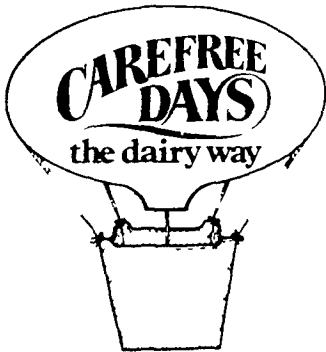

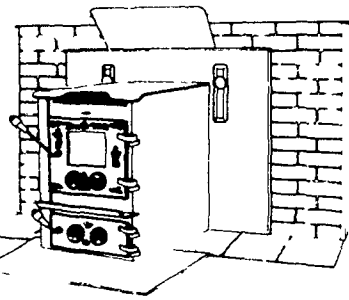
on one side of a standard 8½x11 inches paper and be mailed by the deadline to the above address

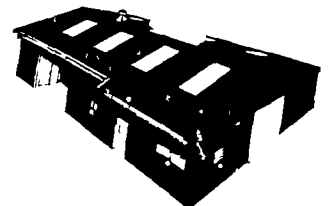

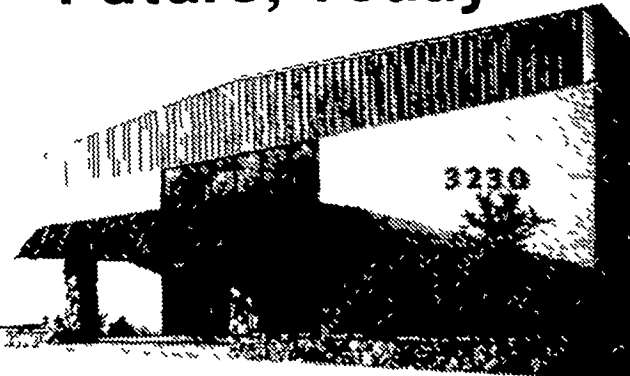

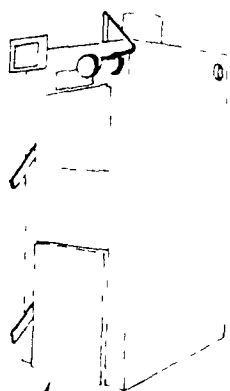
