Miss Gitt's stylish three year old, Penn-Gate Jetstar Queen, was selected as senior and grand champion female of both the open and 4-H shows by judge Don Seipt of Keystone Farms, Easton. Seipt is a Holstein breeder well known throughout Pennsylvania.

Waynesboro, showed senior and grand champion female of the FFA show with his three and four year old dry cow, Reich-dale Pioneer Kitty.

Junior and grand champion bull went to Dyar-Acres Ultimate Riley, a senior yearling owned by Dyar-Acres Holsteins, R1 Shippensburg.

Junior champion of the open show was awarded to Dumbelle Peachum Ingrid, a senior yearling, owned by Dumbelle Farms, R1 Landsburg, while Beverly A. Meyers, Chambersburg, captured 4-H junior champion with her junior

yearling, Aldina Bookmaker Debbie, and Frank Ressler, Shippensburg, garnered FFA junior champion with his junior yearling, Resslerdale New Year Pam.

Smithdale Farms, R5 Shippensburg, was named Premier Breeder and Penn-Gate Farm, R2 Littlestown, was named Premier Exhibitor of the show.

A special trophy in memory of Paul R. Cornman was also presented to Smithdale Farms for the outstanding owner-bred cow in the aged cow class.
