

Farm truck registration now underway

HARRISBURG — Rep Noah W Wenger says the state Transportation Department will begin accepting registration applications August 1 for five new registration classes created under recently passed truck-weight legislation.

Senate Bill 10 raises the allowable gross weights on highways from 73,280 to 80,000 pounds. The limit is permitted only on five-axle combinations if two consecutive sets of axles do not exceed a combined load of 34,000 pounds and the distance between the first and last axle is at least 36 feet.

Wenger said owners wishing to re-register their vehicles in a higher weight class prior to the expiration of the current registration may do so by paying the difference in the old and new fee.

"An identification marker

will be required on out-of-state trucks over 17,000 pounds and will be issued annually by the Department of Revenue for \$25. Violation of the law will result in a fine of \$100 to \$500 for the first offense and \$200 to \$500 and/or 90 days imprisonment for subsequent violations," he said.

Title fees for trucks and other vehicles will increase from \$5 to \$15.

The Lancaster County legislator said citizens taking advantage of these changes should be aware of the following procedures. They can:

Upgrade the weight class of a currently registered truck to one of the five new classes by submitting an MV-41 form (Application for Correction Change of Vehicle Title)

Transfer a current registration to another vehicle of a higher weight class when both are titled in

the same name by submitting an MV-44 form (Application for Transfer of Registration Plate, Renewal Sticker or Class Decal)

Register a newly-purchased truck or truck-tractor at a combination weight which falls into one of the five new classes by submitting an MV-1 form (Application for Certificate of Title) for new vehicles or an MV-4 (Certificate of Title) for used vehicles.

Extend the registration of a currently registered trailer from one to five years by submitting an MV-140 (Request for Registration Renewal When Application Not Received). The validation period would extend five years beyond the expiration date of the current registration.
