

Jr. Shorthorn officers clean up championships

MANHATTAN, Ks. — Ron Alden, the newly elected president of the American Junior Shorthorn Association from Hamilton, Mo., exhibited the Grand Champion female at the 130

head National Junior Shorthorn Heifer Show held here recently.

The crowd of several hundred persons watched intently as 20-year-old

Alden, son of Mr. and Mrs. George Alden, took his class winner to Junior Champion female honors before receiving the traditional slap of champion from Joe Lewis of Alfalfa Lawn Farms, Larned, Ks.

Alden's entry, AF Shannon Margie 924 car, is a May, 1979 daughter of Duke of Swisher and out of an imported Irish dam, Shannon Margie. She weighed 1,055 pounds on show day and measures 52½ inches at the hip.

The Reserve Grand Champion banner went to the newly elected vice president of the American Junior Shorthorn Association, Joe Bales of Morrystown, In.

Bales, son of Mr. and Mrs.

William Bales, exhibited Proffitt's Lady Manuela 105 x, a January, 1979 daughter of Clark x with Windholme Roan Dolly as the dam.

The heifer weighed 1,095 pounds and measured 53½ inches at the hip. She has had a successful show ring career, having recently been named the All-American junior heifer calf for honors received during the 1979 show season.

Exhibitors from 16 states attended the Kansas event, captioned "Decade of Direction" that also included workshops, a seminar program co-sponsored with Kansas State University and a barbecue and dance hosted by Norma and Gene Lindsey at their Little Ponderosa Ranch near the city.

The show was judged under a three man composite team system with Bob Douthett of Windholme Farm, Orange, Va., and Bill Jacobs from California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo, Ca., sharing the duties with Lewis.

Joseph Ehrnthaller dominated the competition for the special awards. He won the Best Bred and Owned division; the Best Owned Pair; won the top showmanship award; and had two entires in the state group of four competition won by his state, Illinois.

Two livestock breeders offer Eastern prizes

TIMONIUM, Md. — Two livestock breeders have offered additional prizes - a purebred steer and \$1000 more in premiums - to the already-announced awards for the 1980 4-H Club and FFA Carcass Steer Contest to be held here on September 27.

Lawrason Sayre, of Waffle Hill Farm, Churchville, Maryland, will present the purebred Angus feeder steer to the youthful exhibitor of the champion carcass steer in the contest. The event will be one of the highlights of the Eastern National Livestock Show at the State Fair Grounds September 26-October 1.

John Mrotek, of Runnymede Farms, Brightwood, Virginia, will donate \$1000 from the sale of a registered Angus heifer to the already-announced prize

money of \$1280.

Competition in the event is open to 4-H Club and FFA members exhibiting steers of any recognized beef breed sired by a registered bull. Steers will be judged in one class for live evaluation and their carcasses will be later evaluated.

The champion and reserve champion awards will go to the highest and second highest indexing carcasses weighing 575 to 775 pounds and grading low choice or better. The exhibitor of the champion, in addition to the award from Mr. Sayre, will receive \$500 and the exhibitor of the reserve champion will receive \$250.

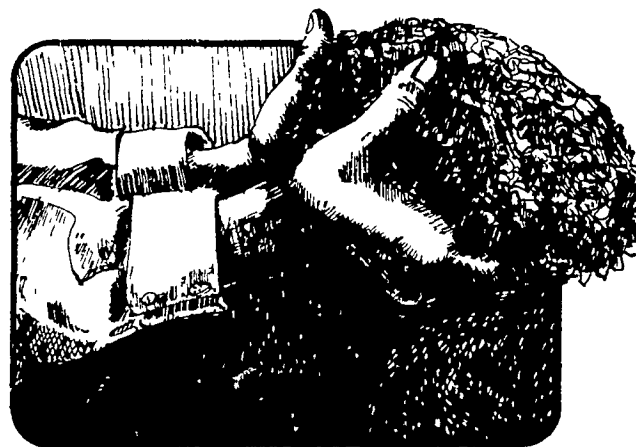
