Environmental groups are asking that the court find that U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Bob Bergland acted improperly when he determined in April of 1978 that a nuclear power plant proposed by the Puget Sound Power and Light Company would not violate the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.

The Skagit has been found to be one of the few

remaining systems in North America which support significant numbers of the five salmon species native to North America, plus three seagoing varieties of trout.

Also, the largest winter concentration of Bald Eagles in the contiguous U.S., more than 200 birds, gather along the Skagit every winter to feed on surplus salmon. Black bear,

waterfowl and black-tailed deer are common in the river basin. It is a favorite of canoeists, hikers and other outdoor enthusiasts.

This is the first major court challenge of the so-called compatible uses along a Wild or Scenic River.



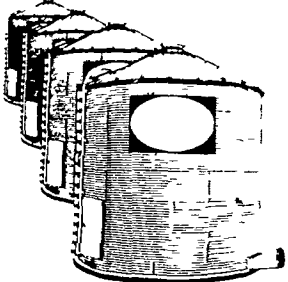
There's no doubt that the West Branch of Octorara has its wild and unspoiled scenery. This is along rocky area near Black Rock.
