

Perry County cow sale tops \$102,000

LANDISBURG — Perry County's dairy princess program was the benefactor of a unique fund raising event, held last Friday evening at the Art Kling sale barn.

It was the third annual Princess Promotional sale, a consignment of registered Holstein dairy animals, with one percent of the total proceeds used to fund the county's dairy promotional activities. A record-breaking \$102,500 of sales was generated during the spirited two hours of auc-

tioning.

Dumbelle Starlite Lynette, a Roybrook Starlite heifer bred to a son of Elevation, and out of an Elevation dam with 28,000 of milk and over 1100 fat, topped the sale at \$4800. She went to Aryie Breedyk of Chino, California, and has been consigned by Dumbelle Farms, Landisburg.

A Citation R Maple daughter with a 2-year record of over 15,000 milk brought the second high price of \$4000. From a dam with records over 20,000, she was purchased by Robert Bailor, Mifflintown. Con-

signers were Kenneth and Jane Benner of Millerstown. Whit-Lane Farms of Mercersburg was final bidder on the third place seller, a 3-yr. old Elevation daughter sold for \$3600. With a first lactation record of almost 16,000 pounds, she was from a Mil-Key Comet

Sovereign dam with over 19,000 milk. Richard Kriebel of Millersburg R1 was the consignor.

The thousand dollars plus raised by the sale will boost the efforts of Perry County's enthusiastic and hard-working Princess Lisa McMillen, and her alternate

Cheryl Byers.

Lisa is 18 and the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Dean McMillen of Loysville R1. A June graduate of West Perry High School, Lisa will be a freshman at Mt. Alto campus of Penn State, majoring in therapeutic recreation.

A former 4-H queen, in 1978-79, Lisa is in her ninth year of club membership. Admitting that she's tried almost every area of the program, including a year of dairy work, Lisa says that the horse and pony club is her favorite. Also an en-

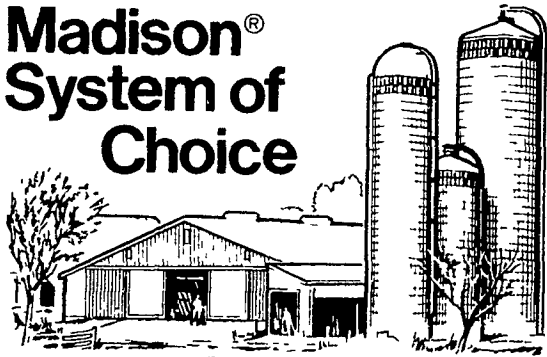
