# PSU. ag writers cited

UNIVERSITY PARK — Superior awards were received by four members of Penn State's College of Agriculture communications staff in the 1980 critique and awards program sponsored by the Agriculture Communicators in Education.

Awards were announced at the international organization's recent annual meeting at the University of California-Berkeley.

The educational materials produced by agricultural communications faculty and staff are designed to serve the needs of all Pennsylvanians, points out Glen W Gross, director of agricultural communications.

Keith F Stevens, radio-TV producer-host, received a superior award for a filmed television feature, "Extensions," produced in cooperation with WPSX-TV.

Charlotte C Murphy, extension news editor-direct mail coordinator, won a superior award for editing and producing "Communications Express," a communications training letter. The letter was prepared by Mrs. Murphy featuring contributions from other members of the ag communications staff.

Rae D Chambers, publications designer-illustrator, won a superior award for designing "Woodlands and Wildlife", a popular miscellaneous publication. The publication was authored by Robert G Wingard, Terry D Rader, et al, extension forest resources specialists, and edited by Neil E Dowlin, writer-editor.

Glenn D Bengtson,

technical publication editor, received a superior award for a technical research publication, "Sorghum and Pearl Millet Disease Identification Handbook." The entry was edited by Bengtson for the International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid Tropics headquartered in India.

It was authored by sorghum pathologists from Texas A & M University, the International Crops

Research Institute in India, and French research organizations for tropical agriculture in Bombay Senegal.


