GETTYSBURG — Four young ladies will compete for the title of Adams County Poultry Queen on August 16. The 1980 queen, Jo Ann Deatrack, Littlestown, will preside over the evening's festivities.

Competing for this year's title will be Penny Crabill, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joe Crabill, New Oxford; Michele King, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Dale King, York Springs; Melissa Shetter, daughter of Mr. and

Mrs. Ed Shetter, Gettysburg and Joanne Sterner, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Sterner, Biglerville.

The contest will be held at the Lamp Post Restaurant, Gettysburg, beginning at 6:15 p.m. with a social hour. The social hour will feature the queen candidates serving hor's d'oeuvres. Following dinner the contestants will present a two to three minute talk.

The evenings en-

tertainment will feature singing from the Hanover Area Barbershop Quartet.

Melissa Shetter will be a senior at Gettysburg Area Senior High School. She is captain of Gettysburg Rifle Squad, President of Adams County 4-H Dairy Goat Club and raises capons as a 4-H project. She is also a member of the 1980 state winning 4-H poultry judging team.

A senior at New Oxford High School, Penny Crabill is a member of Girls Leaders Club and Future Business Leaders of America. She also is a member of the basketball,

volleyball and softball teams.

Michele King is a member of the band, chorus, field hockey, and softball teams at Bermudian Springs High School. This high school junior is also a member of the York Springs Community 4-H Club, Adams County 4-H Senate and 1980 state winning 4-H poultry judging team.

Joanne Sterner, a senior at Biglerville High School, is a member of the Honor Society, band, volleyball team and Spanish Club. She is also a member of the 1980 state winning 4-H poultry judging team.

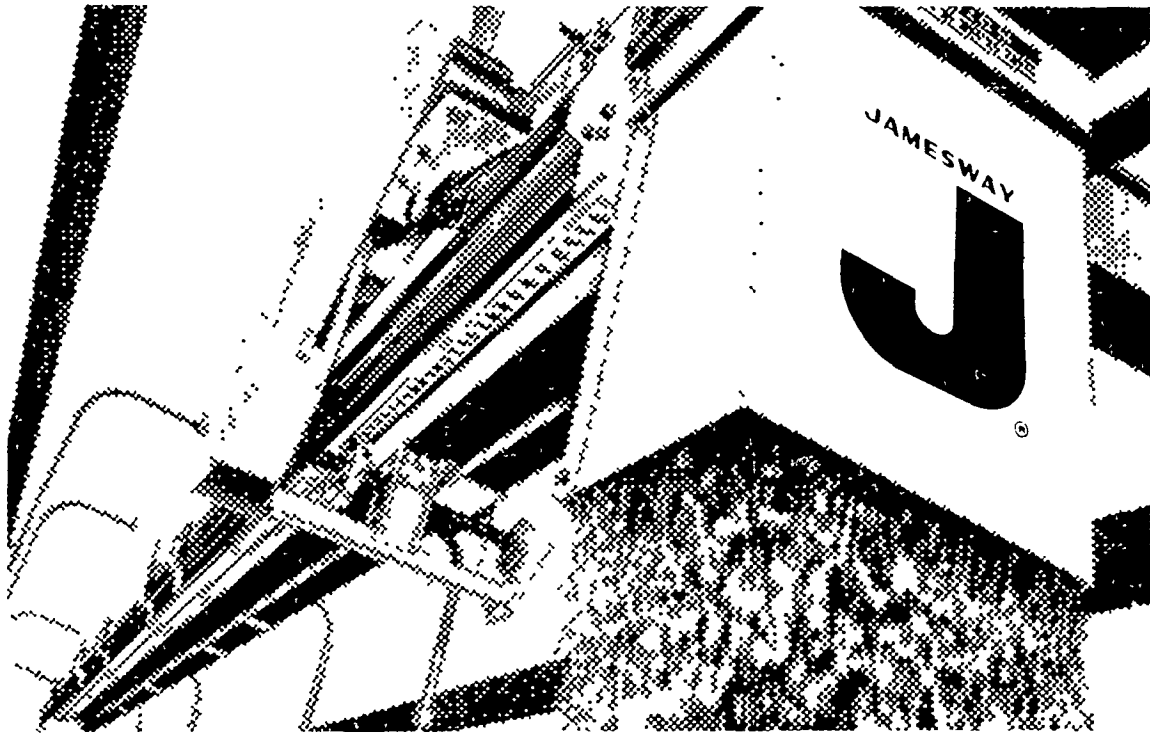
First place flower judges

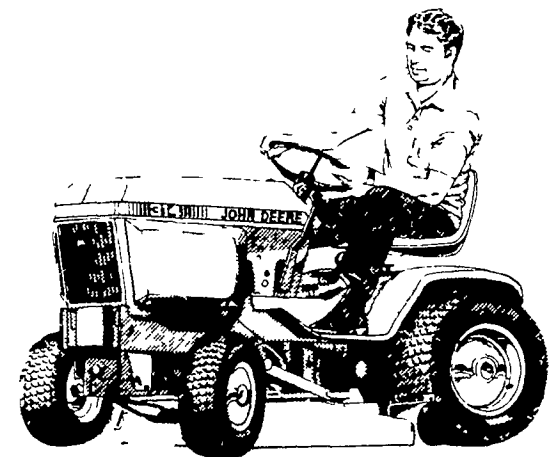
