Two potato handlers pay assessments

WASHINGTON, DC — Eldon Tessmen, a potato handler at 6508 85th Ave North, Brooklyn Park, Minn., paid \$1394.43 in assessments due from 1972 to 1976 for handling 159,443 hundredweight of potatoes. Charles H. Meadows, president of M&W Farm, Inc., in Atmore, Ala., paid \$978.14 in assessments due from 1973 to 1978 for handling 97,814 hundredweight of potatoes.

Both complaints, filed in U.S. district courts, were withdrawn by U.S. attorneys, after the potato handlers settled the actions voluntarily.

The national potato research and promotion plan requires certain handlers to

file reports and pay one cent per hundredweight assessments, which they may deduct from the payments due to producers. Assessments are used to finance potato research and promotion activities carried out by the potato board.

USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service works with the board in administering the program.

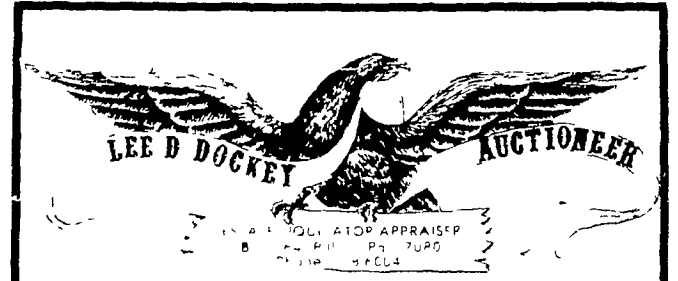
