As Regional Star American Farmers, each will receive a cash award of \$500 from the National FFA Foundation, Inc., at the 53rd FFA National Convention, November 12-14, in Kansas City, Missouri.

Although a majority of FFA members are high school students, the Star Farmer of America recognizes older members who have been out of school for at least one or two years. The award is established purposely to honor these older members since a student established in farming or ranching a year or

two after graduation from high school has proven his desire to make a career of farming
