Egg board

nominations requested

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Certified egg producer organizations are being asked to nominate prospective member and alternates to the American Egg Board, Secretary of Agriculture Bob Bergland announced today.

The 18-member board administers the egg research and promotion order authorized by the Egg Research and Consumer Information Act.

The nominations, due Sept 1, are to fill upcoming vacancies caused by the expiration of terms for nine members and their alternates at the end of 1980. The new terms will be for calendar years 1981 and 1982.

The current North Atlantic states members, whose terms will expire at the end of this year, are Emanuel Hirth, Manchester, Conn., and Maurice S. Cohen, alternate, Hollis Center, Maine; Norman J. Hecht, Walden, N.Y., and John A. Ricca, alternate, N. Billerica, Mass.

These board members may be renominated, Bergland said. Under the terms of the act, members are eligible to serve three consecutive terms. Nominations are to be made by the 60 egg producer organizations, associations or cooperatives certified eligible by Bergland.

The egg research and promotion order provides that certified organizations

within an area can meet for the purpose of jointly nominating members and alternates. Nominations should be sent to Thomas H. Porer, director, Livestock, Poultry, Grain and Seed Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, Washington, D.C., 20250.

Md. Grange grants deaf education scholarships

The Maryland State Grange has created a special new program to provide scholarships in the education of the deaf, and earlier this year formed the Deaf Scholarship Committee to administer this program. The formation of this scholarship program in the field of education of the deaf represents a continuation on the part of the Grange of its program of work with the deaf.

On August 5 the Deaf Scholarship Committee met to review applications for the 1980-1981 school year. A number of applications were reviewed and the Committee has selected two persons who will be awarded \$500 scholarships.
