State mushroom output drops for second year

HARRISBURG — Pennsylvania, the leading state in mushroom production harvested 213.7 million pounds of mushrooms during the 1979-80 season, down less than one percent from a year earlier.

This is only the second drop in Pennsylvania's production since estimates began in 1967, and the second consecutive year of decline, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

Pennsylvania fresh market sales totaled 70.0 million pounds, up 14 percent, while processed sales in the commonwealth declined by six percent to 143.7 million pounds. The sales value of fresh market mushrooms in Pennsylvania for the 1979-1980 season was \$59.4 million compared to \$54.6 million during the 1978-1979 season.

The sales value of processed mushrooms was \$82.2 million compared to \$98.3 million a year ago.

Pennsylvania put 73.0 million square feet into production during the 1979-1980 crop year, an increase of less than one percent compared to 72.7 million square feet a year ago.

Intentions for 1980-1981 crop year are 69.0 million square feet, a decrease of six percent from this crop year. Pennsylvania continues to dominate production with 45

percent of nation's total. During the 1978-1979 crop year, Pennsylvania produced 47 percent of the nation's total.

Mushroom production in the United States reached a record 470 million pounds, four percent above a year earlier and 18 percent more than the 1977-1978 crop. The value of sales in the United States for fresh market totaled \$245,116,000, compared to last year's \$217,770,000.

Processed mushroom sales were valued at \$123,431,000, compared to \$144,030,000 for the 1978-1979 crop.

An estimated 151 million square feet of bed and tray area was used in the production of mushrooms in the U.S. during the year, up three percent from the previous season.

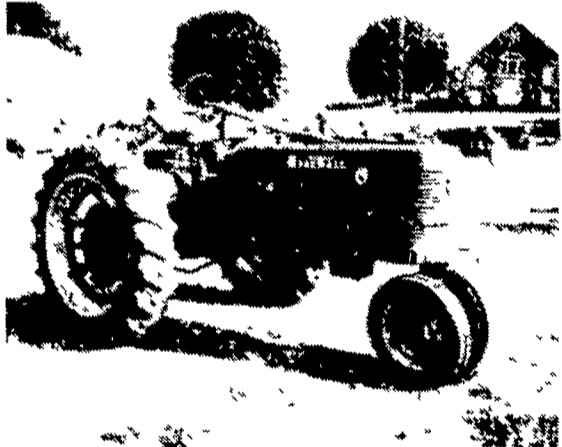

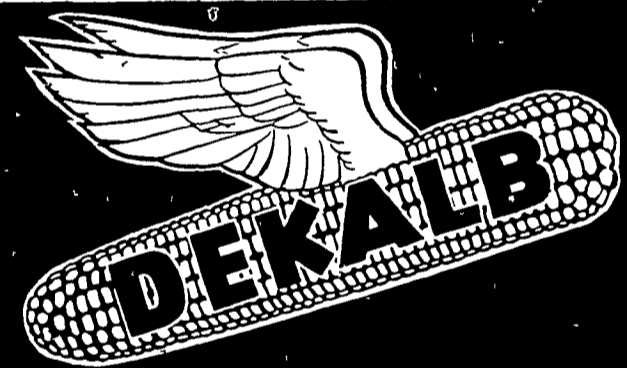
