SUMMARY: Compared to last week, slaughter steers ended the week mostly 1.00 higher. Heifers .50-1.00 lower. Cows closed firm to 1.50 higher. Bulls remained steady. Trade on slaughter cattle slow and cautious in reaction to a sharply lower dressed beef trade. Choice steers and heifers weighing over 1100 and 900 lbs. Respectfully found good demand, however, lighter weights and mixed Good and Choice consignments under pressure. Receipts this week were about 4100 compared 3547 last week and 5812 a year ago.
