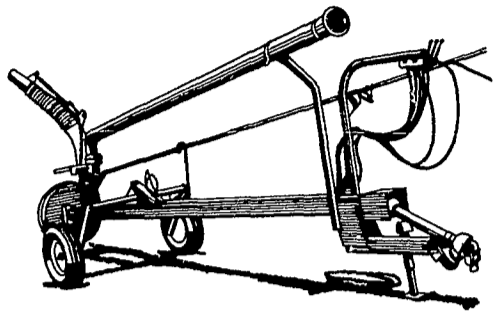


# Moore takes top two places at Franklin Fair Guernsey show

In the 4-H and FFA Show Grand Champion honors went to a three year old owned by Patricia Ann Layman of Waynesboro while Reserve Grand Champion went to Jeffrey D.

Benedict, also of Waynesboro, and his dry three and four year old.

Douglas Layman, Waynesboro, was named Junior Champion of both the open and 4-H Show with his senior yearling heifer while John W. Mummert, Chambersburg, was selected as Reserve Junior Champion, open and 4-H, with his junior calf.

During the 4-H and FFA Showing and Fitting Contest,

Allen Mummert of Chambersburg was selected by the fitting and showing judge Eugene Schuiman of Clymer as Grand Champion Showman and Grand Champion Fitter.

Allan is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Kenneth Mummert.

In the Jersey open show, Timothy Donough, Chambersburg, walked away with an armload of trophies and ribbons as he won Grand
