## National group seeks rural award recipients

ANNAPOLIS, Md. — Raymond Philip Shafer, Chairman of the National Rural Center's Selection Trustees, has recently announced that a nationwide search has been launched for nominees for two \$10,000 rural service awards, according to Maryland Secretary of Agriculture, Wayne A. Cawley, Jr.

Each year the Winthrop Rockefeller Award for distinguished Rural Service is awarded to two individuals who have made

important contributions to rural America. A \$10,000 check is given to each winner and competition for the prestigious award is keen.

The awards, Governor Shafer explained, are aimed at honoring individual leadership in local communities and in the academic community. Each nominee must have at least one specific contribution through a project or program that affects a rural area or areas.

In addition, the project must deal with an important national or regional problem. It must be adaptable to other rural areas and it must have a potential for long-lasting impact. Innovation is also a factor, Shafer said.

The search for 1981 nominations began in June with a September 10th deadline. For 1981 nominating forms and information, contact the National Rural Center, 1828 L Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20036.
