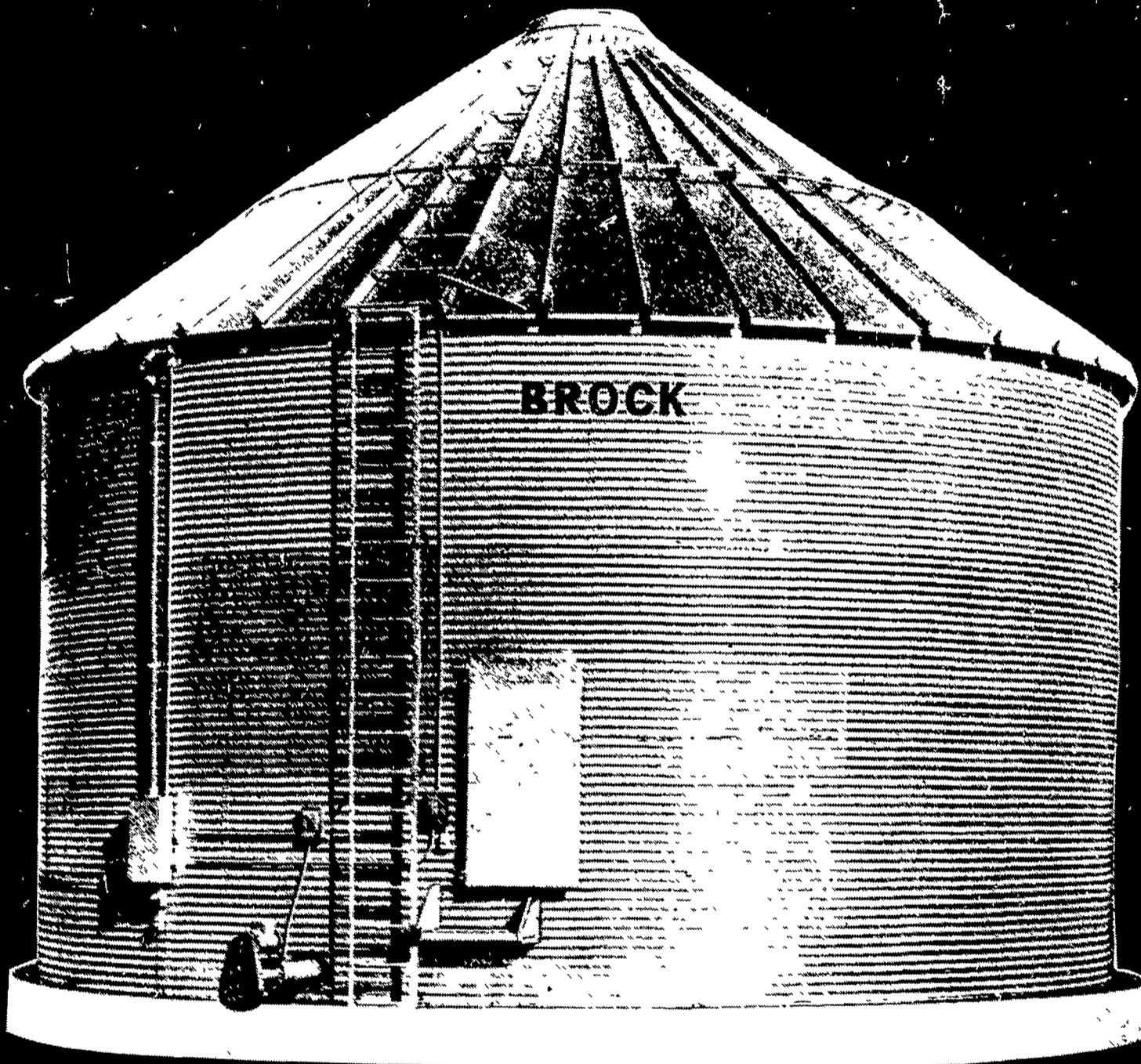

- Reduce the 40-inch fill hole width to 24 inches.
- Eliminate the exclusive fill hole collar seal.
- Eliminate the circle of safety steps.
- Eliminate the adjustable roof stiffner ring.
- Eliminate 3-inch high roof ribs.
- Make the roof pitch less than 35 degrees.
- Eliminate the safety handrail by the manhole.
- Eliminate the tab between each rafter.
- Switch to a lighter gauge steel sidewall.
- Use lower grade bin bolts and washers.
