

Southeast 4-H dairy show winners chosen

KUTZTOWN — 4-H members representing eight southeastern Pennsylvania counties converged at the Kutztown Fairgrounds, here, to compete in the 35th annual Southeast 4-H Dairy Show.

A total of 226 dairy animals were exhibited at this event held last Saturday by 150 4-H members who held hopes of qualifying for

the Pennsylvania Junior Dairy Show, scheduled for Monday, September 22. Blue ribbon winners at this show are eligible to send a maximum of two blue merit animals to the state show.

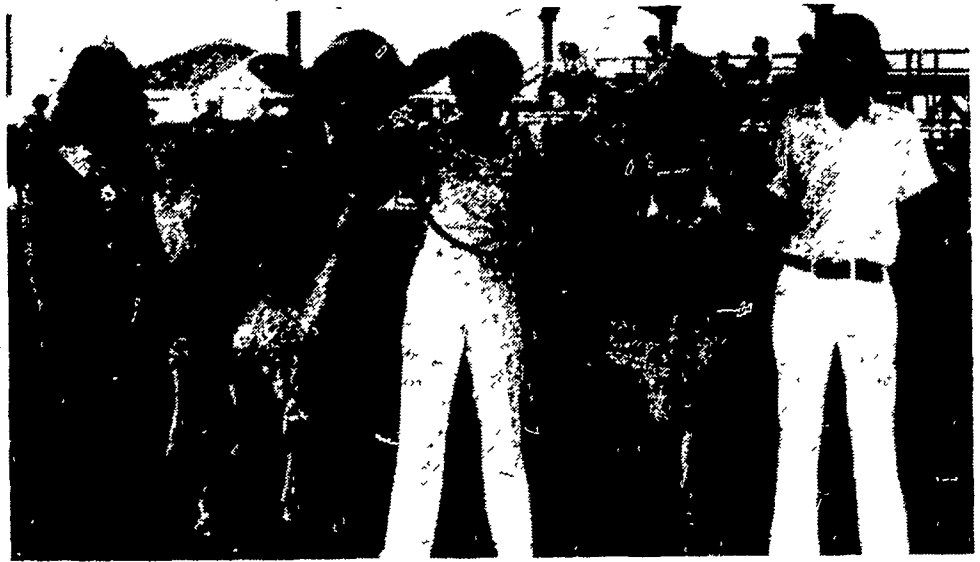
Judges for the show were, Eugene Francisco, Holstein Breeder, of Andover, New Jersey, and Harry Roth of Atlantic Breeders Co-operative. Participating counties included Berks, Bucks, Chester, Lehigh,

Montgomery, Northampton, and Schuylkill.

Entries included 111 Holstein, 38 Jersey, 33 Brown Swiss, 23 Guernsey, 18 Ayrshire, and 3 Milking Shorthorn.

Taking Grand Champion titles home were: a two year old named Sue Ellen, exhibited by Helen Seidel, Kutztown in the Holstein Breed; an aged cow named Tower View Kelly's Heather,

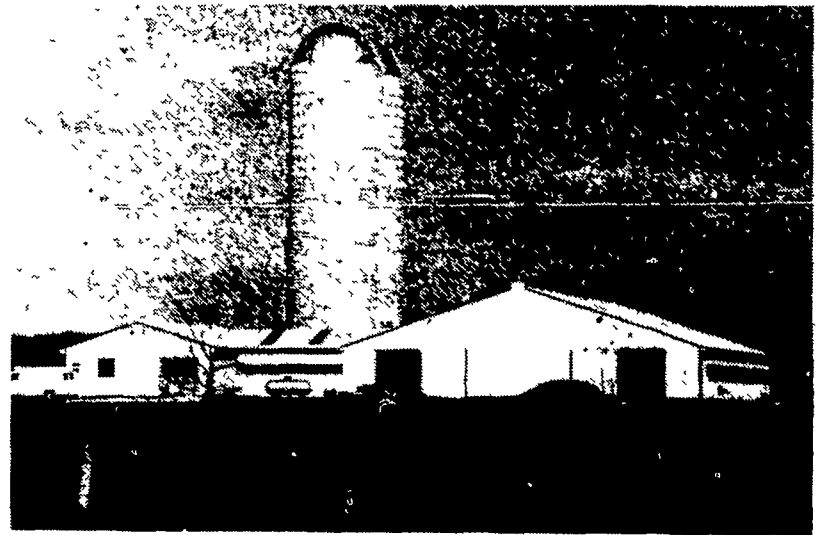
