

Montgomery Co. Sheep Show champions posted

GAITHERSBURG, Md. — Last week's list of champions of the Montgomery County Fair was missing one important part, according to Pennsylvania sheep exhibitors who brought home some trophies — the sheep show results.

Two Pennsylvania breeders captured the grand championships in the Open Dorset and Shropshire shows.

Suzie and Bob Leib, owners of Shepherds Crook Farm, Mechanicsburg, took both grand championships in the Dorset competition with their ewe and ram entries.

The champion Shropshire ewe was exhibited by a Charles and Barbara Platt, from Gettysburg.

In the Suffolk competition, Troy Ness, Dallastown, showed the champion ram.

Other champions in the open show included: Carol Irvine, Gaithersburg, Md. — Cheviot ewe and ram;

George Pasley, New Windsor, Md. — Corriedale ewe and ram; Mary Hope, Knoxville, Md. — Hampshire ewe and ram; Susan Schoeman, Clarksville, Md. — Southdown ram; Kimberly Reinhold, Gaithersburg, Md. — Southdown ewe; Mary Rauschenberg, Woodbine, Md. — Suffolk ewe; and Mr. and Mrs. Edward Beall, Germantown, Md. — Shropshire ram.

In the 4-H competition, Carol Irvine once again had the champion Cheviot ewe and ram.

The champion Dorset ewe was shown by Sue Coleman, Boyds, Md., while Joseph Hagerty, Clarksburg, Md. exhibited the champion Dorset ram.

Jeff Hagerty tied up the championship ribbons in the Shropshire classes. The Clarksburg youth had both the top entries in ram and ewe competition.

Kimberly Reinhold's ewe was once again a champion in the 4-H show, along with her Southdown ram.

And, Juan Maldonado, Gaithersburg, Md., showed the champion Suffolk ewe and ram.

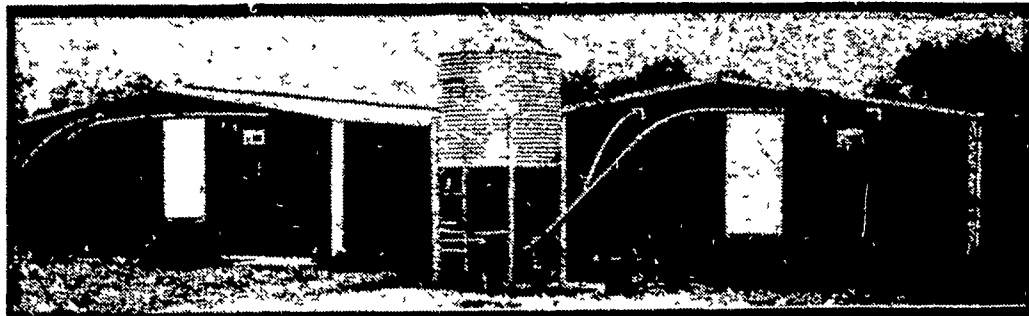
