The nine-lesson course includes instruction on how to slaughter, dress and cure meats; location of different

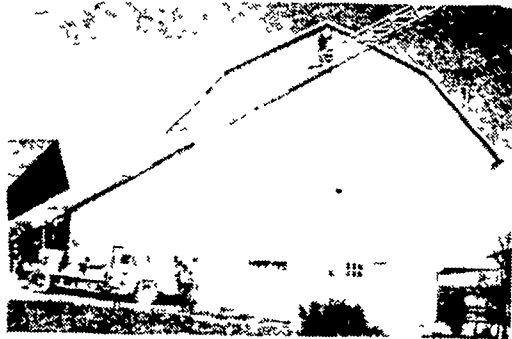

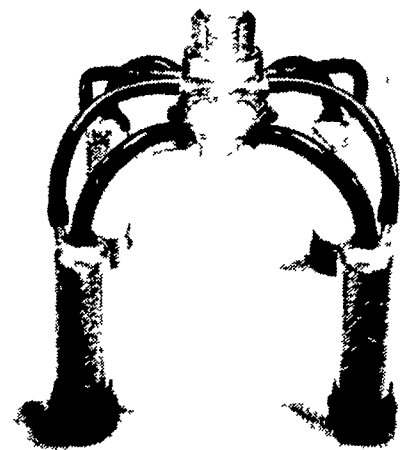

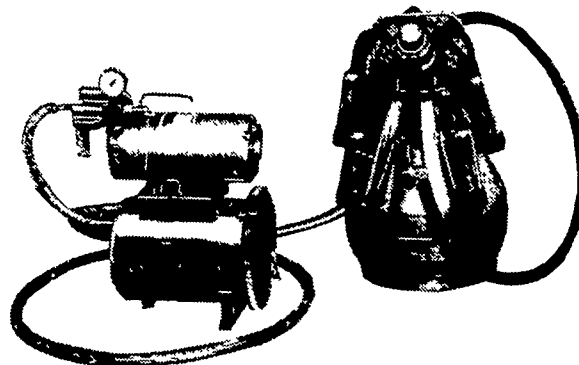
