Order 4 milk price set at \$14.64

ALEXANDRIA, Va. — Middle Atlantic Order Market Administrator Joseph D. Shune today announced a Class I milk price for October, 1980. This price is up 13 cents from the September price and is 77 cents above last October.

Order No. 4 prices are announced for milk testing 3.5 percent butterfat, f.o.b. plants located within 55 miles of Philadelphia, Pa. and also within 75 miles from the nearer of Washington, D.C. or Baltimore, Md. There is also a 6-cent direct-delivery differential applicable to producer milk received at plants located within 55 miles of Philadelphia.

Shune announced a Class II

milk price of \$11.98 per hundredweight for August 1980 and a butterfat differential of 16.6 cents for the month. The Class II milk price increased 20 cents from the previous month while the butterfat differential was up six tenths of a cent.

These class prices are based on the August 1980 Minnesota-Wisconsin manufacturing milk price of \$11.86 per hundredweight adjusted to a 3.5 percent butterfat content.

The USDA reported that the wholesale price of Grade A butter at Chicago for August was \$1.4446 per pound and the nonfat dry milk price was \$.8917 per pound, f.o.b. plants in the Chicago area.

Broiler chick placements up

HARRISBURG — Placements of broiler chicks in the Commonwealth during the week ending August 30 were 2,237,000, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

The placements were four percent above the corresponding week a year earlier and three percent above the previous week. Average placements during the past nine weeks were slightly below a year earlier.

Placements in the 21 key

poultry producing states were 73,072,000, three percent above the previous week but four percent below the same week a year earlier. Average placements during the past nine weeks were four percent below a year ago.

Broiler-fryers slaughtered in Pennsylvania under federal inspection during the week ending August 20 totaled 2,065,000 with an average liveweight of 3.94 pounds.

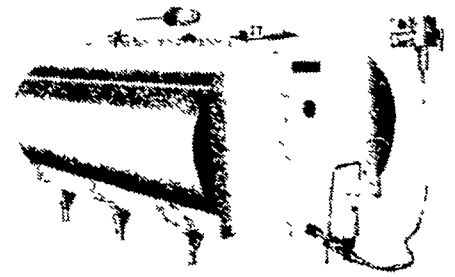
