In the category of club exhibits Trappe won a Champion in Class while a scrap book entered by

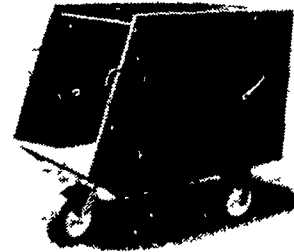
Salford won a similar award.

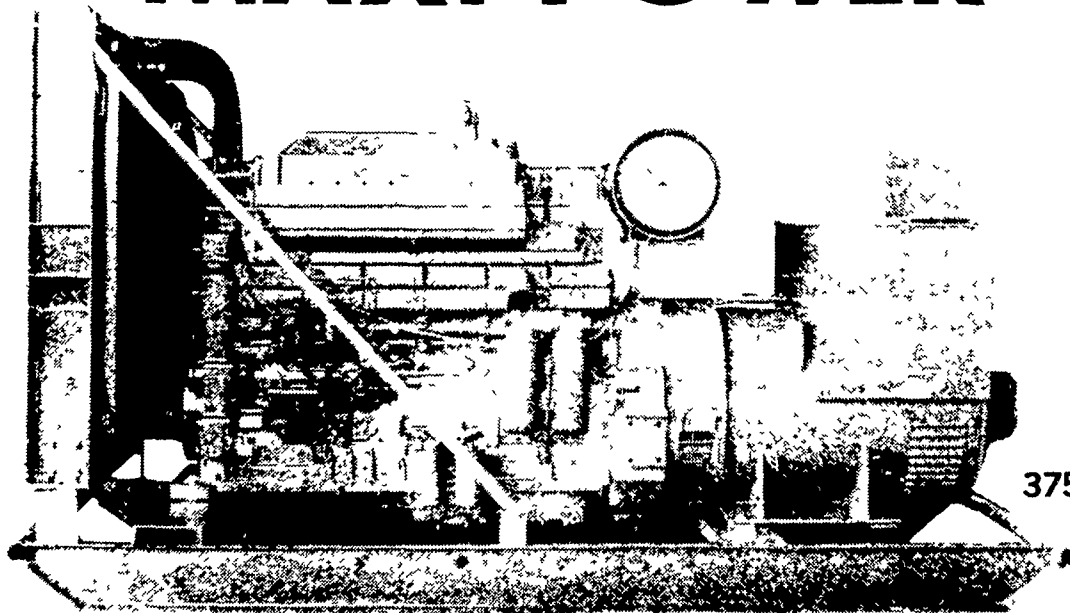

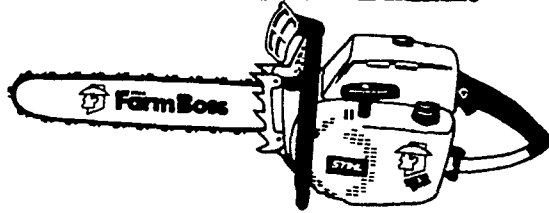
