yearling sale held on Wednesday and Thursday here at the Farm Show Complex

When the first leg of the 42nd annual sale finished up early Thursday evening, the Hanover consignment had beaten the field of 314 head and was the highest selling yearling at \$200,000.

The colt, toled February 21, 1979, is sired by the famous pacer, Albatross, whose record stands at 1:54 3/5 minutes. His dam, Adorna Hanover, is also a pacer with a record of 1:57

According to Hanover's foreman, Edward Miller, about 65 percent of the two-year-old Albatross colts and fillies have finished their first track season with records of 2:00 minutes or less.

Thus, plus the colt's ancestry which includes the popular stud Meadow Skipper and the infamous Tar Heel, account for the colt's \$2 grand price tag.

Seven other yearlings left the sale arena wearing price tags of \$100,000 or more

Included in this elite group were two other Albatross foals Blanche Hanover, a bay filly, brought \$120,000 while her pasture mate Ramda Hanover, also a bay filly, came in at \$110,000.

Two Meadow Skipper foals also topped the \$100,000 mark. A brown colt, Gumbel Hanover, left the sales arena when bidding stopped at \$175,000 His half-sister, Ria Hanover, sold for \$155,000

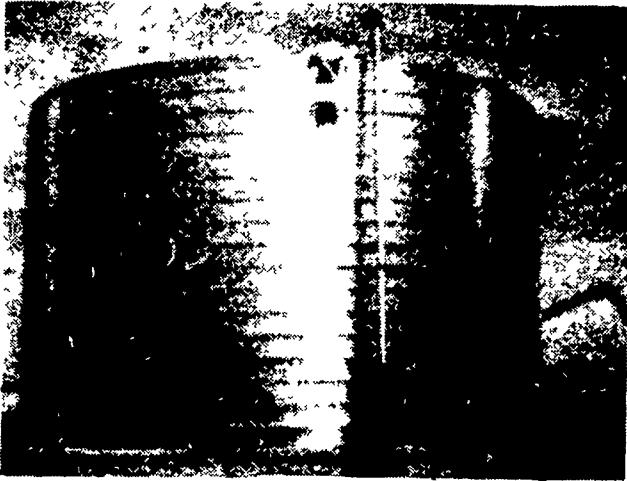
Gordon Hanover, a bay colt by Texas out of Golden Link, sold for \$135,000.

Arden Hill Farms, Inc., Bethel Park purchased a bay colt, K.D Hanover sired by Sampson Direct, for \$110,000.

Technical Foul, a brown colt by Most Happy Fella, sold for \$120,000

Hanover Shoe Farms Inc consigned 110 yearlings for a total of \$4,459,000, averaging \$40,536. The sale total for the 314 head consigned came to \$7,990,500, averaging over \$25,000.—SM

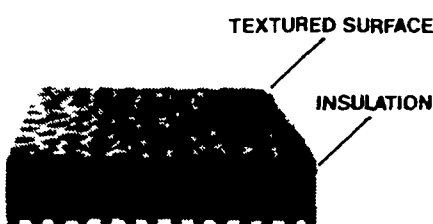
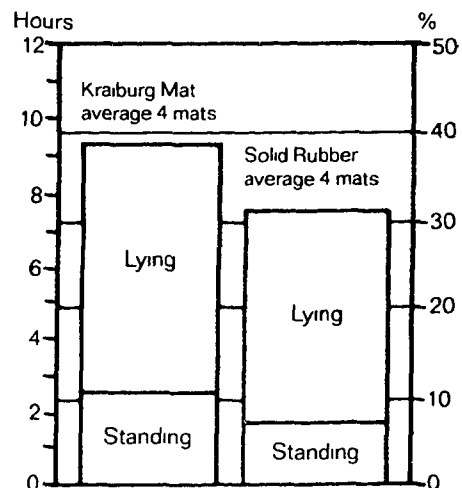
