Leaning silo

Then, slowly, ever so slowly, the silo was jacked into an upright position. Only 5 or 6 strokes of the jacks were made at a time. After each series, wood wedges were driven under the silo to hold it in place and the jacking then continued.

All in all, the leaning side was raised more than six inches. Any cracked staves were repaired and then a base foundation collar was poured to fill-in below the

raised portion

According to engineer Stanek, it was a pretty routine job.

His greatest straightening task so far was a New York State silo that was some 69 inches off center.

Regardless, drivers motoring along Wood Corner Road no longer will need to blink and rub their eyes or scratch their heads when they encountered the leaning silo of Ephrata Township — DA

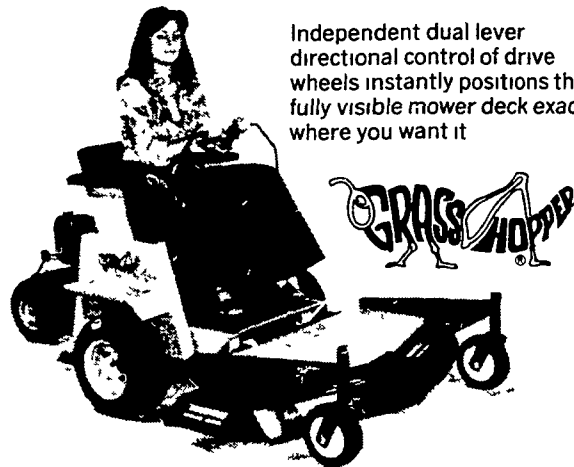

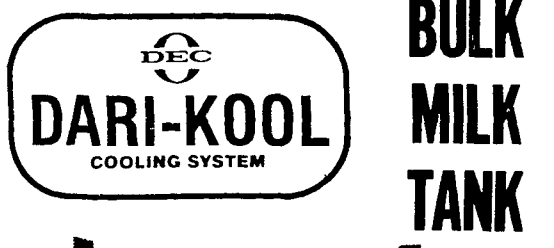
