COTTAGE EGG SPREAD

1½ cups small curd cream-style cottage cheese, well dramed

1 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

1/4 teaspoon pepper

1/4 teaspoon dry mustard 4-6 drops hot pepper sauce

8 hard-cooked eggs, chopped

Combine in a medium bowl with seasonings, stirring until blended. Stir in eggs. Cover and chill several hours or overnight to blend flavors. For brown bagging, tote the spread in a small thermal jar and spread on the bread just before serving.

HONEY SANDWICH SPREAD

½ cup peanut butter

½ cup nutmeats

½ cup cut-up dates enough honey to spread

Combine the ingredients and use as a sandwich filling.

MOLASSES CRINKLES

34 cup shortening

1 cup brown sugar

1 egg

½ teaspoon salt 2 teaspoons soda

1 teaspoon cinnamon and ginger

4 tablespoons black strap molasses

21/4 cups flour

½ teaspoon cloves

Cream shortening and sugar. Add egg and molasses and beat well. Add the sifted dry ingredients and mix thoroughly. Chill dough and make 1 inch balls. Roll in sugar. Bake at 350° F. for 12-15 minutes. Makes 4 dozen cookies. Keep the cookies soft by placing in a tight container and adding ¼ of an unpeeled apple.

BROWNIE HONEY CAKE

²/₃ cup honey ½ cup shortening

2 eggs

2 cups flour

2 teaspoons baking powder

½ cup milk

1/4 cup pecans

1 teaspoon vanilla 4 tablespoons cocoa

½ teaspoon salt

Cream shortening and honey. Add eggs, one at a time. Beat well and add sifted dry ingredients alternately with the milk. Add other ingredients, pour into well greased loaf pan, and bake for 30 minutes at 350°F.

PHILADELPHIA CREAM CHEESE

Take 1 gallon of buttermilk that has turned thick and add 1 gallon of boiling water. Mix thoroughly and allow to drip dry in a cheese cloth.

4 tablespoons milk

4 tablespoons soft shortening

3 squares chocolate, melted


1 teaspoon vanilla
