(Continued from Page C30) periodically test any cattle in question, such as newly purchased cattle.

Protect against other diseases

I have been concentrating all my comments on Brucellosis thus far. But, many of the same precautions will also help protect your herd from many of the other communicable diseases that can easily infect cattle. Minimizing the movement of cattle in and out of the herd - less showing, buying and selling - will also reduce the risk of spreading diseases. Risk is also reduced by using artificial insemination in preference to using bulls that have been used for natural service in a number of different herds. Good ventilation and control of vectors (birds, flies, etc.) is

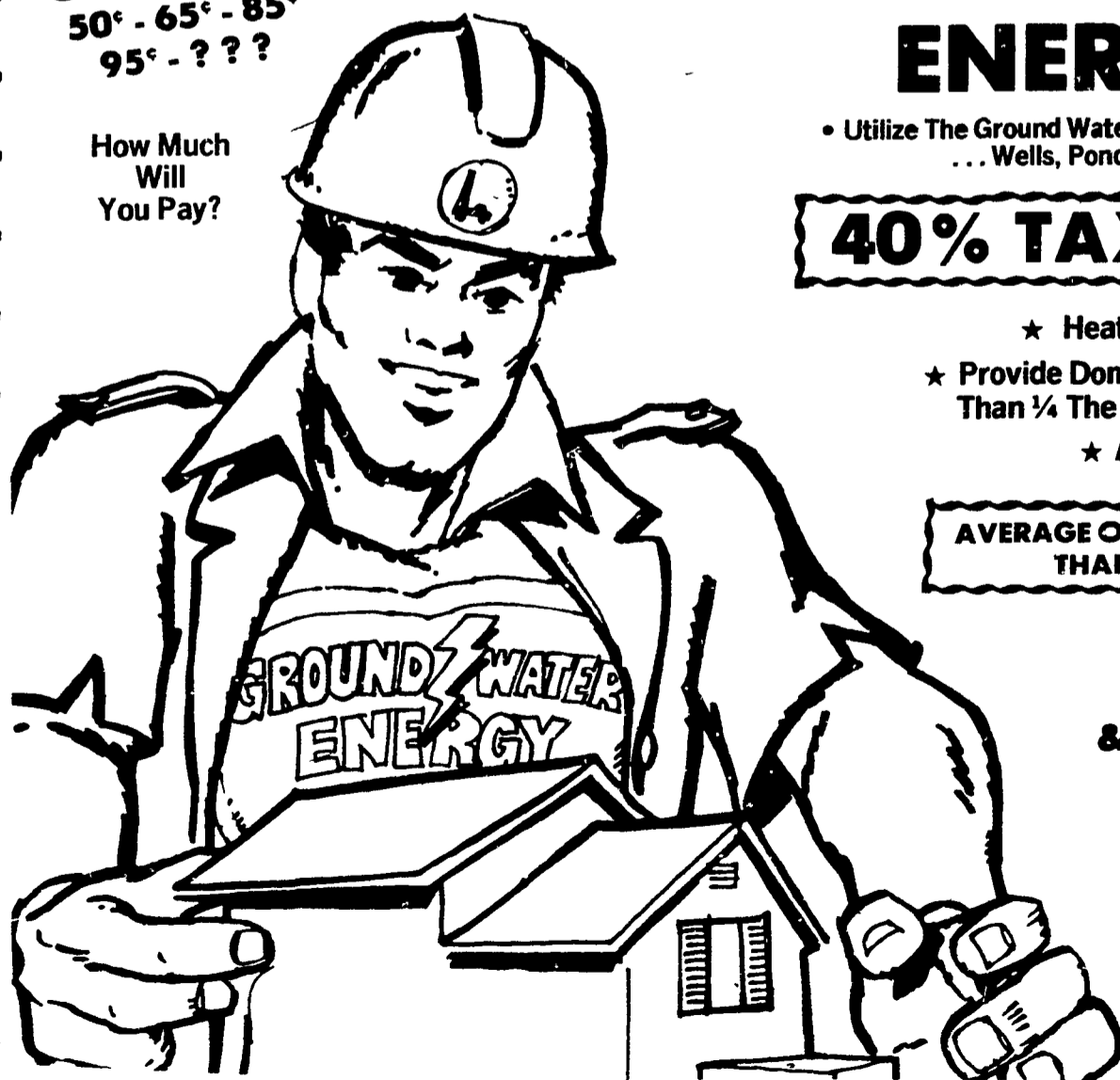
also a good precautionary practice.

Healthy, disease-free cattle are a very valuable asset to dairymen. We can't afford to let down our guard. Let's get serious about controlling cattle diseases by cracking down on any offenders and by sharpening our own precautionary measures.

Be sure to work closely with your veterinarian to develop a good, preventive herd health program for your herd.
