

Frederick and Carroll counties dominate Maryland 4-H dairy show

TIMONIUM — Frederick and Carroll counties, the top counties in milk production in Maryland won thirteen of the fourteen major awards given at the Maryland 4-H Dairy Show.

Frederick County began its impressive string of eight wins by dominating the Holstein show which is always competitive. The Frederick 4-H members swept all the major awards given.

David S. Hill, 18, of Emmitsburg had the senior and grand champion cow. His three-year-old cow, Hills-Hope C. Cindy, was later

chosen as the Supreme Champion, chosen from all breed champions. For this honor, Dave received the J. Homer Remsberg Memorial Plaque.

O. Christopher Smith, 15, of Jefferson won the Holstein fitting and showing championship and was later awarded the George Debnam, III, Memorial Plaque as the over-all champion in dairy cattle fitting and showing. This is the third year in a row that a Frederick county 4-H member has won this award.

Frederick and Carroll counties shared the colored dairy breed championships.

Ayrshire winner was Eugene Baker, 17, of Lineboro with his aged cow, Piney Grove Flashy June.

Brown Swiss winner, Marie Bassler, 15, of Rockey Ridge showed her aged cow,

Sand Rock Captain Ruby.

Guernsey winner was Thomas Powell, 18, of Union Bridge with Unicorn Mistress Sandy, an aged cow.

Jersey winner, Kathy Kahler, 16, of Keymar showed Gaywinds Golden Crissy, an aged cow.

Milking Shorthorn honors were won by Dawn Bell, 17, of Manchester with her aged cow, Trickle Brook D.J. Lorrie. Dawn also won the breed fitting and showing championship.

Other breed champions in the fitting and showing contest were: Jersey - Janet Stiles, 14, of Gaithersburg; Guernsey - Thomas Powell, 17, of Union Bridge; Ayrshire - Steve Hobson, 15, of Taneytown; and Brown Swiss - Kelly Harding, 14, of Lewistown.

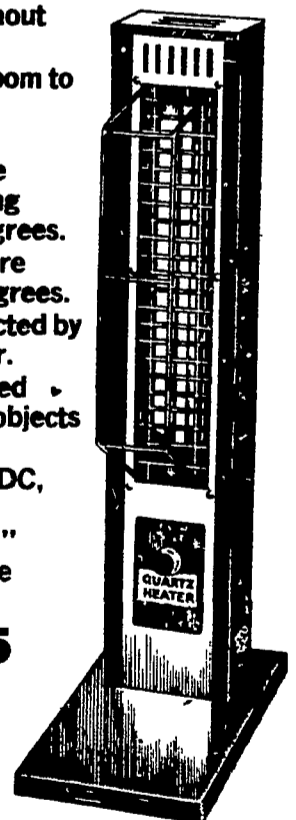
