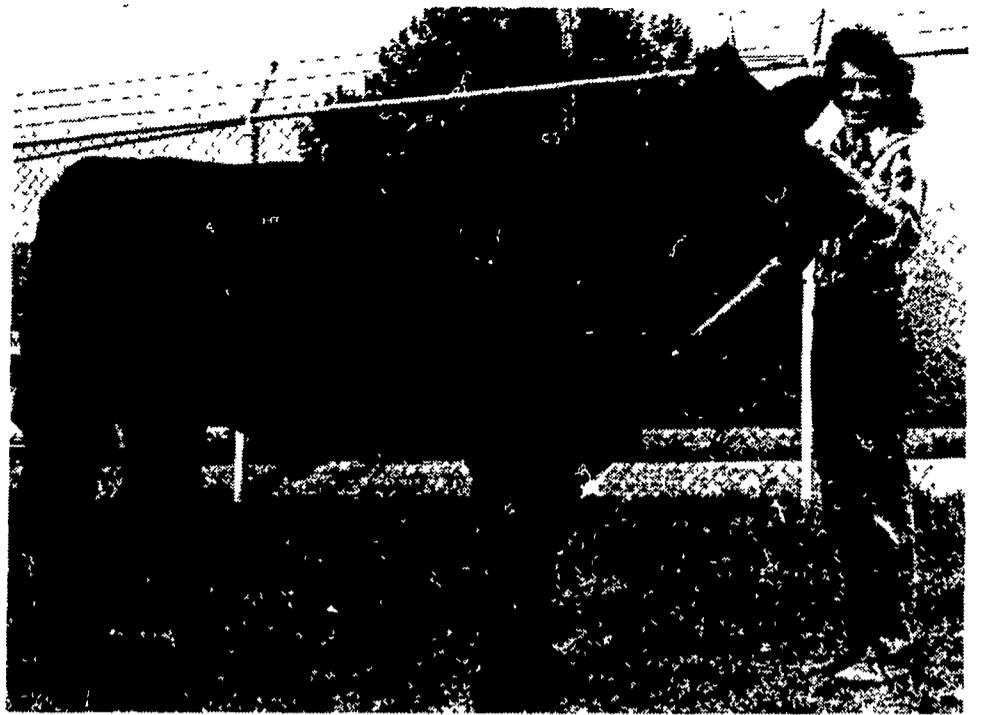


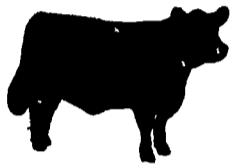
Ivan Bechtel, R2 Halifax, showed his crossbred steer to the reserve championship.

PA vegetable contest winners' recipes available free

ROCK SPRINGS — More than 250 recipes were entered in the first Pennsylvania Vegetable Recipe Contest held recently at Rock Springs, Centre County.

Altoonan Judy Burchfield's Cucumber Hors D'Oeuvres conquered the

judges' palates to become the winner and walk off with the \$100 first prize. Burchfield combined cucumbers, cream cheese and Italian dressing mix to make a delicious spread which would be welcome at a family outing as well as a dinner party for friends.

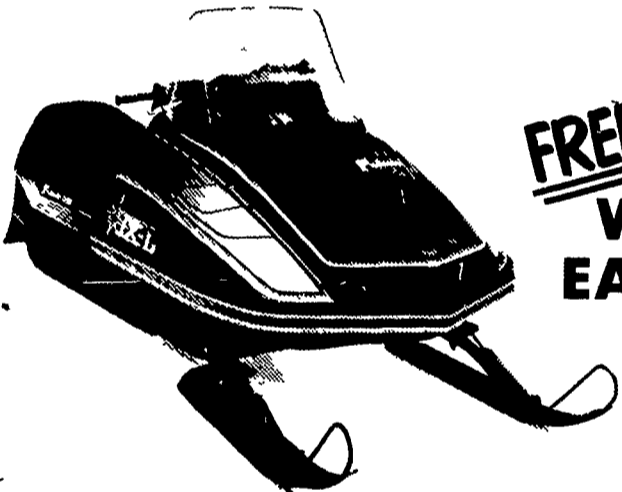
Mrs. Geary W. Huntsberger of Etters, York County, won third prize with her creation, Super Beef and Squash Casserole. Using

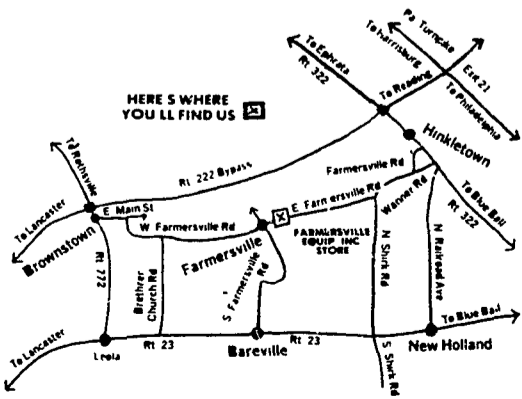

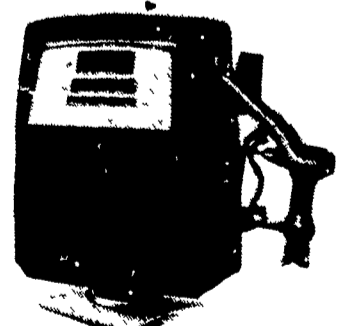
