HERSHEY — United Egg Producers will be represented at Northeast Egg Marketing Association's Annual Meeting at Hershey, on October 1, 2, and 3, according to an announcement made Wednesday by Bill Rent, NEMA's General Manager.

Claude Silva of Turlock, California, President of U.E.P., will be attending all of the sessions, while Douglas Hoffer of Warsaw, Indiana, is slated to address the Annual Banquet on the evening of October 2nd.

Hoffer is sales manager of the well known Creighton Brothers egg operation at Warsaw and is Vice President of a wholly owned subsidiary, Crystal Lake Egg Products, Inc.
