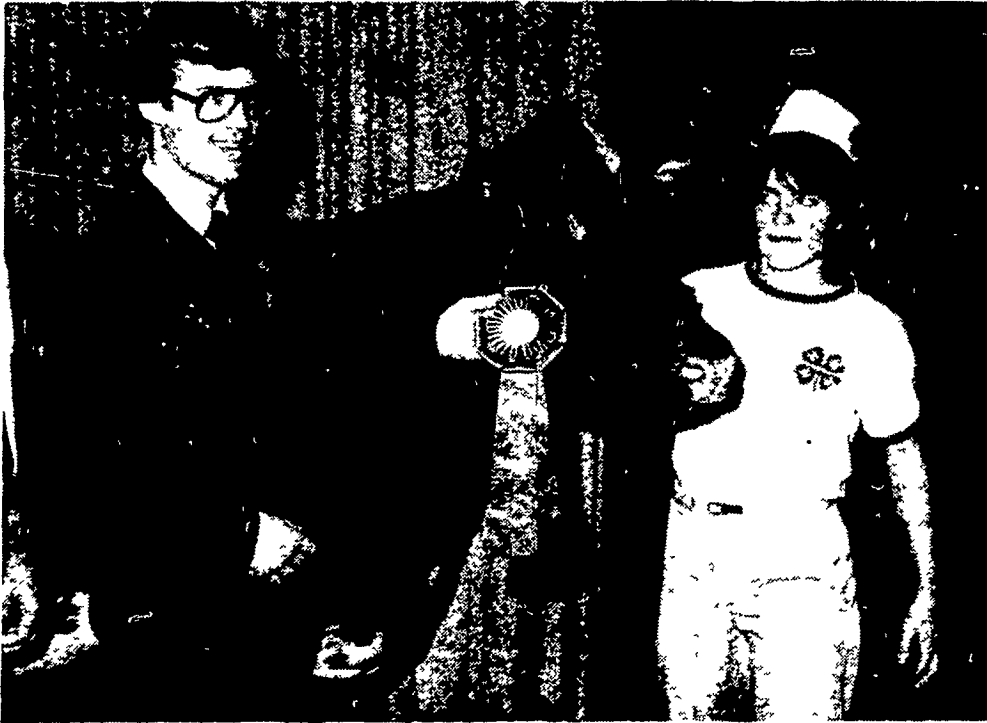

recognized as Master Fitter during her class competition.

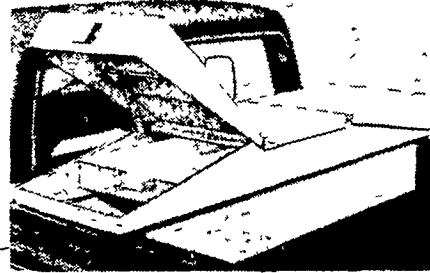

pion and was the best uddered cow in her class. Henley was picked as Master Showman.

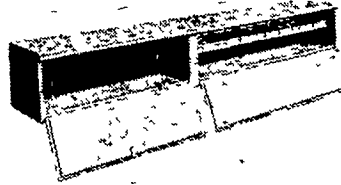
This marks the fifth straight year that Henley has won the grand champion honors in the state's Junior competition.

York County's Scott Cooper, from R2 Delta, took

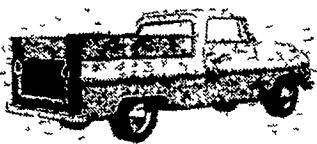

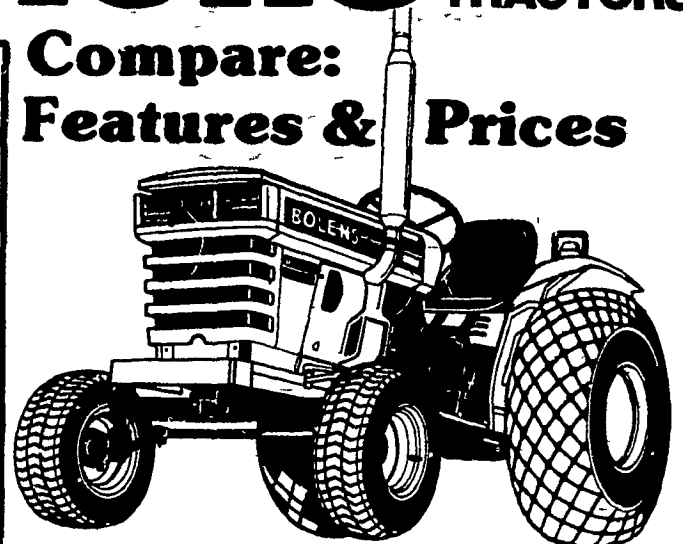

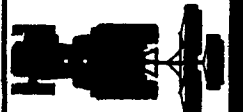
