## Potato chip firm cited for slow pay

QUAKERTOWN Crouthamel Potato Chip Co., Inc., Quakertown, has been cited by the U.S. Department of Agriculture for failing to pay promptly for \$462,821 woth of potatoes that the firm purchased.

USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service, which licenses produce firms under the Perishable Agricultural Commodities Act, had charged the firm with failing to make full payment promptly for 187 lots of potatoes. The potatoes were purchased between October 1978 and October 1979.

Charles Brader, marketing official with AMS, said the Crouthamel firm did not answer the charges, and agency's USDA's Administrative law Judge Dorothea A. Baker

committed willful, repeated, and flagrant violations of the

Under Baker's order, the firm may not conduct business subject to the act until September 2, 1982, and then only if a PACA license is obtained.

Also, the firm's officers, directors, and major stockholders -- Willard Roberie Crouthamel, John Willard Crouthamel and Anthony J. Mazullo, Jr. may not be employed by or affiliated with any PACA licensee until September 2, 1981, and then only if a surety bond is posted and USDA approves.

The PAC Act establishes a code of good business conduct for the produce industry. It provides for

ruled that the firm had collecting damages from anyone who fails to live up to contractural obligations in buying or selling fresh and frozen fruits and vegetables.

Interstate traders must be licensed, and USDA can suspend or revoke a trader's license for violating the act.
