Yield checks of the control areas where little or no control of shattercane was obtained revealed that the corn yielded only 44 percent of the corn yield checked in areas where good control was obtained

Corn in the control areas had extremely small ears, many barren stalks, and the corn was not as mature as that in the clean areas of the plot

Effective (commercially acceptable), although not 100 percent complete, control was achieved with the Eradicane (7 3 pint rate) and the Eradicane (3.5 pint) plus Sutan (3 pint) combination.

• Sutan (5 pint rate), double incorporated, gave moderate to good control on two of the three farms.

Sutan (5 pint rate) single incorporated, and Prowl (3 pint rate) reduced weed population considerably but not to a commercially acceptable level

Little or no control of shattergrass was achieved with the two control treatments
