

# York County Holstein named grand champion

**HARRISBURG** — Northcroft Ella Elevation, owned by Woodbine Holsteins, R2 Airville, York County, moved from state to national prominence all in the span of a few short months this year.

The six-year-old Holstein, competing in the aged cow class, went on from winning her class to capture grand champion female honors at the 1980 Eastern National Holstein Show last week.

Earlier this year, on April 10, she took similar honors at the 27th Pennsylvania

Holstein Show, which was also held in the Farm Show Building.

Sired by Round Oak Rag Apple Elevation, she is out of Northcroft Ella Arlinda. As a four-year-old, her production record totaled 34,107 lbs. of milk and 1369 lbs. of fat.

The reserve grand champion female, C Sunnydene Ned Ginger, was exhibited by Winter Place, of Winslow, Me.

The first-place state herd was shown by the Pa.

Holstein Association, of State College.

Premier breeder and exhibitor of the show was Pinehurst Farms, of Sheboygan Falls, Wisc. Round Oak Rag Apple Elevation, owned by Select Sires, of Plain City, Ohio, was named premier sire.
