York observes 4-H Week

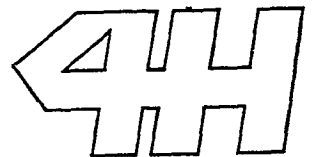
YORK — The York County has 1400 4-H members and 300 volunteer leaders participating in the observation of National 4-H Week October 5-11.

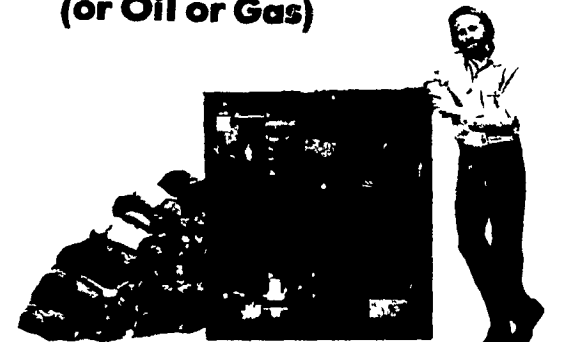
