

Simmental Trait Leader bulls named

BOZEMAN, Mt. — The American Simmental Association recently announced 68 purebred Simmental bulls, including 14 that qualified in more than one category, are recognized as Trait Leaders for 1981.

Based on data contained in the 1980-81 National Simmental Sire Summary, these Trait Leaders include bulls whose progeny lead the breed in six important economic traits - calving ease, weaning weight, yearling weight, carcass value, daughters' first calf calving ease, and daughters'

first calf weaning weight. "This recognition is based upon an evaluation of the performance records from 1038 bulls listed in the 1980-81 Sire Summary" said Executive Secretary Earl B. Peterson. "A total of 411,341 performance records from 38,315 management units were considered. Publication of comparative performance data is an automatic feature of the ASA system.

To qualify as a Genetic Trait Leader in the Simmental breed, a bull must be used in at least two herds

and have 20 or more progeny whose performance ranks in the top two percent of all those reported in the breed.

Each year when the Sire Summary data is printed, the list of elite sires is published. A bull can be named in more than one trait provided his progeny continue to rank among the best in the breed.

Data on all 1038 bulls and a complete listing of every trait leader is contained in the 1980-81 National Simmental Sire Summary which will be released on or before November 1, 1980.

Farmers for Carter name dairyman state chairman

MILLVILLE — Pennsylvania's Farmers for Carter Committee today announced the appointment of Christian F. Wolff, Jr., a dairyman from Columbia County, as its Chairman.

In partnership with his son, Dennis, Wolff operates the 360 acre Pen-Col Farms near Millville.

The dairy farm boasts a renowned herd of registered Holstein cattle, and Wolff was presented the Master Farmer Award in 1978. He is a member of the State board of the Pennsylvania Farmers Association.

"I am honored to have been asked to serve as chairman of the Pennsylvania Farmers for Carter Committee," Wolff said, "because it will give me the opportunity to talk to farmers about the important agricultural achievements of President Carter.

"Jimmy Carter has done a

lot for agriculture in four years. Many people have forgotten the chaos in agriculture that Jimmy Carter inherited when he became President, and even more need to be reminded what this Administration has done in order to correct those problems," he said.

Wolff and other officers of the state committee are in the process of organizing county and regional chapters of Farmers for Carter. Meetings will be held across the Commonwealth, coordinating local and state efforts to distribute information that spells out the Carter record in agriculture.

This record includes: Nearly doubling the value of agricultural exports in four years from \$22.7 billion to \$40 billion and increasing the tonnage from 114 million to 162 million,

Establishing the Nation's

first farmer-owned grain reserve,

Proposing and signing a new Meat Import Law to ensure a viable domestic livestock industry, and Supporting the Agricultural Conservation Program with a \$190 million appropriation.

"I'm convinced that when Pennsylvania's farmers take time to compare the record of President Carter to the statements of Ronald Reagan, they will vote for Jimmy Carter," Wolff said.
