Orville Yoder, Bradford County Agent explained that Power will conduct educational programs in Bradford, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Tioga, and Wyoming Counties. He is headquartered in the Regional Cooperative Extension Service office in Wysox, Bradford County.

Power will be available to help individuals with tax assistance and tax management questions. He will be conducting meetings ın estate plannıng; a seminar to acquaint bankers with farm financial problems; and a three day school on farm management record keeping for young farmers.

Prior to being named to the Penn State Extension staff, he was teaching and research assistant and an occupational therapy aide. He also served as an officer in the U.S. Army.


Power is a member of the American Agricultural Association, Economic American Economic Association and Northeast Association of Agricultural Economics.
