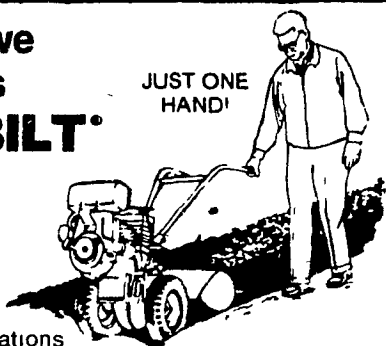

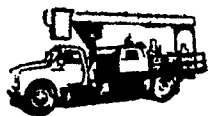

WYSOX — Lehan R. Power, Jr., recently appointed farm management extension agent for the Northern Tier Extension Region, was introduced to the Bradford County Extension Service Executive Committee at their regular September meeting held in the Extension offices in Towanda.

Orville Yoder, Bradford County Agent explained that Power will conduct educational programs in Bradford, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Tioga, and Wyoming Counties. He is headquartered in the Regional Cooperative Extension Service office in Wysox, Bradford County.

Power will be available to help individuals with tax assistance and tax management questions. He will be conducting meetings in estate planning; a seminar to acquaint bankers with farm financial problems; and a three day school on farm management record keeping for young farmers.

A native of Arlington, Massachusetts, he received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Northeastern University in 1968, majoring in business administration

and a Bachelor of Arts degree in agricultural economics in 1978 from the University of Massachusetts. He is completing requirements for a Master's degree, also at the University of Massachusetts.

Prior to being named to the Penn State Extension staff, he was teaching and research assistant and an occupational therapy aide. He also served as an officer in the U.S. Army.

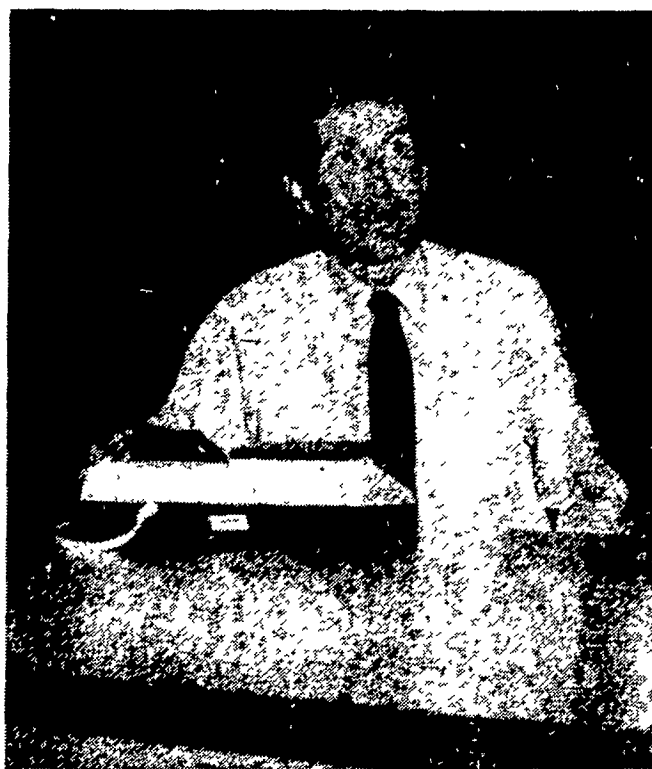
Power is a member of the American Agricultural Economic Association, American Economic Association and Northeast Association of Agricultural Economists.

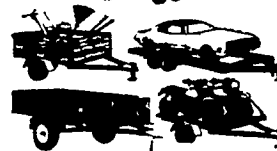
