HERSHEY — Penn's Agri-Women held their 4th Annual Convention last Tuesday at Hershey Convention Center. Ethel Gross, Pres. Manchester, York Co. presided. Joyce Hershey, Chester County, was Spokeswoman for Young Farmers. The afternoon session was highlighted with a talk by Richard Zook, York, representing the

Federal Land Bank Association. Gail McPherson, York County, was elected President for 1981. Gail gave a preview of what will take place at the American Agri-Women's Convention. This convention will convene Sunday, November the 9, and continue through the 14th at Hershey Convention Center. Each day there will

be a Media Communications Workshop lasting from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m.

Monday's opening session will be on the Incredible Bread Machine. On the panel will be Hiram Drachey and Susan Sechler. The afternoon session will include Peg Rogers, director of food advisory board, talking on critical food issues.

Tuesday's opening session will be Washington On The Line and will include an international panel of foreign agricultural attaches representing Australia, Brazil, and the Netherlands. Moderator will be Larry Waterfield, Washington, editor of the "Packer".

Land use, importing and exporting, fruit and vegetable trade will be discussed.

Following a luncheon, Eileen Nutting, Agriculture

Advisory Committee, Michigan Department of Agriculture, will talk on The Double Burden of Soviet Farm Women. The afternoon session Tuesday will include a debate, Should Food Be Used as a Foreign Policy Tool?

Wednesday there will be a convention tour to Donegal Mills Plantation, Groff's Restaurant for lunch and to Sperry New Holland's plant.

Thursday morning's topic will be People on the Farm with Lilly Vincent, director of Consumer Information for the USDA. There will be a panel of AAW Affiliate Presidents put on the spot answering questions and criticisms by non-farmers. This panel will include Laura Heuser as moderator with Ann Herr, WGAL-TV, and Ann Kaiser, Wisconsin, Editor of "Farm Wife" magazine.

WALNUT PIE

- 1 cup sugar or less
 - 1 cup water
 - 2 eggs well beaten
 - 1 cup molasses or less
 - 1 tablespoon cornstarch or flour
 - 1 cup nuts of any kind
 - (for 6 pies take 2 quarts whole English walnuts).
- Mix all together and bake in crust.

LITTLE PUMPKIN CUPS

- 2 envelopes whipped topping mix
- 1 cup milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon cloves
- 1/4 teaspoon ginger
- 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
- 1/2 can (16 ounce size) pumpkin (about 1 cup)
- 1 bag or less of candy corn

Line 12 muffin cups with baking cups. Prepare the topping mix as directed on envelopes, using a total of 1 cup milk and 1 teaspoon vanilla but add the sauces before heating. Fold in the pumpkin with rubber scraper.

Pour mixture evenly into muffin cups. Decorate each with candy corn. Refrigerate for a couple of hours before serving.

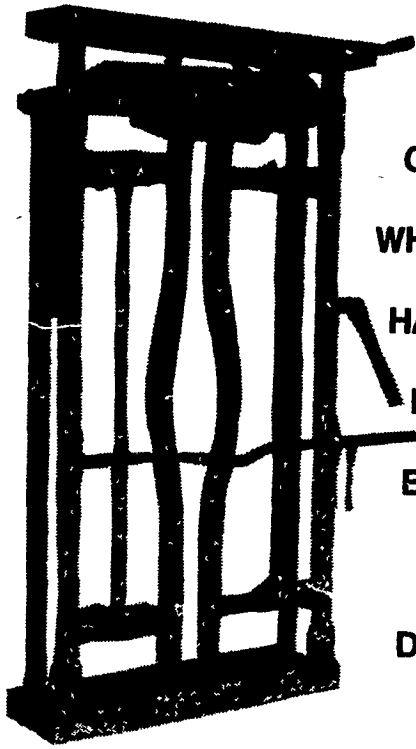

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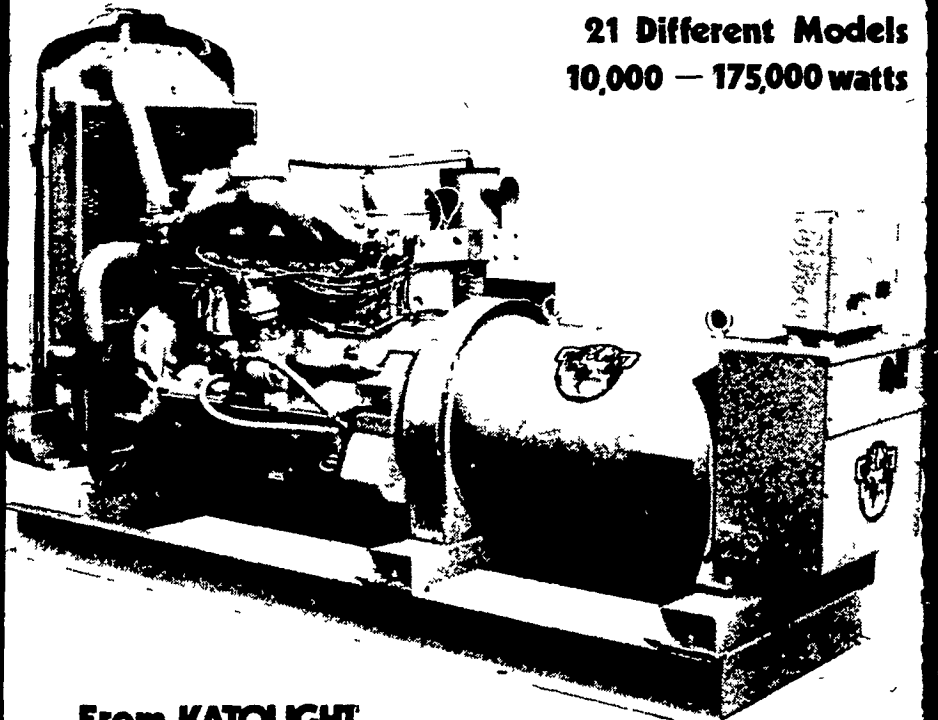


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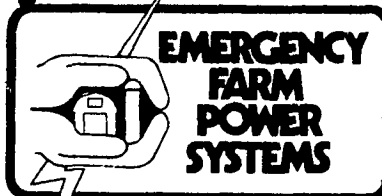
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
