Pa. shepherds take breeding sheep champions

HARRISBURG - Pennsylvania exhibitors took home championships in the Keystone International Livestock Exposition, held here at the Farm Show Complex last week, in both the Shropshire and Rambouillet breeding sheep shows.

William E. Yoder of Kutztown went home to his Berks County farm with the champion Shropshire ewe. This was WEY Shrops first year in competition at KILE.

The WEY ewe, R. Stokes Fam. 228, was the first place ewe in her class, 1 year and under 2, before being tagged the best Shropshire female of the show by judge Gary Ricketts, Urbana, Illinois.

In the Rambouillet competition, Bradford County's Kenneth T. Moore captured both the ewe and ram championships with his entires. The champion ram was Moore's fall lamb, and the champion ewe was his yearling entry.

Moore was the Premier Exhibitor of the Monday afternoon show. He had the first place exhibitors flock,

along with both reserve championships for his yearling ram and fall ewe lamb.

Moore also exhibited the reserve champion Cheviot ram in Friday's Cheviot Breeding Sheep Show. The ram was the second place spring lamb and stood behind the show's grand champion.


