

Grangers herald farm bills

HARRISBURG — Charles Wismer, Master of the Pennsylvania State Grange heralded the passage of the bill declaring Johnsongrass a noxious weed, as a long-awaited boon to agriculture. Wismer, called the bill "another step" another step in increasing farm productivity in Pennsylvania.

Johnsongrass is a weed that virtually takes over fields in farms throughout the state. After taking over, field crop yields drop drastically because they are unable to compete for soil nutrients.

The State of Maryland has control programs for the

weed. Without a noxious weed designation in Pennsylvania, there was nothing to prevent its spread here.

Two other bills the Grange had worked for final passage also awaiting Governor Thornburgh's signature, are the Inheritance Tax revisions and laws regulating spotlighting.

The revisions to the Inheritance Tax allow a farm to be valued at its use-value, rather than its market value.

"Now that we have this measure," Wismer stated, "heirs no longer have to sell off portions of the farm in order to pay the tax."

Another bill of importance

to the Grange forbids carrying weapons while spotlighting, and prohibits shining lights on barns and outbuildings.

"This is a measure the more rural members of our organizations have been seeking for a long time," Wismer noted.
