 the show with SBF Miss Joggess 325, a late junior yearling heifer entry.

Taking the reserve champion heifer spot was HFF Miss Trustee 341, the second place late junior yearling heifer exhibited by Barbara Ann Metch of Flemington, New Jersey.

In the Junior Hereford competition, Elizabeth Mullinix captured the champion heifer title with BLR Dominette A153, a spring yearling heifer entry. Pennsylvania Junior steer exhibitors split championships with out-of-staters during the Junior 4-H and FFA Steer Show.

Greg Prouty of Norwich, Ohio, exhibited the grand champion junior steer of the show. His crossbred steer was winner in the heavyweight class, 1220-1235 pounds. The steer went on to defeat the champion steer in the Open Show, and earned the title of Grand Champion.

Helen Molitor of Fayetteville, Ohio, captured the reserve champion steer of the Junior show title with her first place heavyweight steer entry, 1165-1215

pounds. Molitor's steer was tagged reserve grand champion of the KILE steer competition.

Chester Countian Sheila Fairbairn of West Chester captured the champion lightweight steer title with her crossbred entry. Reserve champion lightweight steer was shown by Emily Livingston of Dover, York County.

In the middleweight division, Ricki Seese of Indian Head, Fayette County, showed the champion steer. Reserve champion middleweight steer was shown by Joel Park of Postoria, Ohio.

Other Pennsylvanians placing first in their class include: Becky Webster of Halifax, Dauphin County, in the lightweight division and Wayne Hess of Conestoga, Lancaster County, in the mediumweight division.

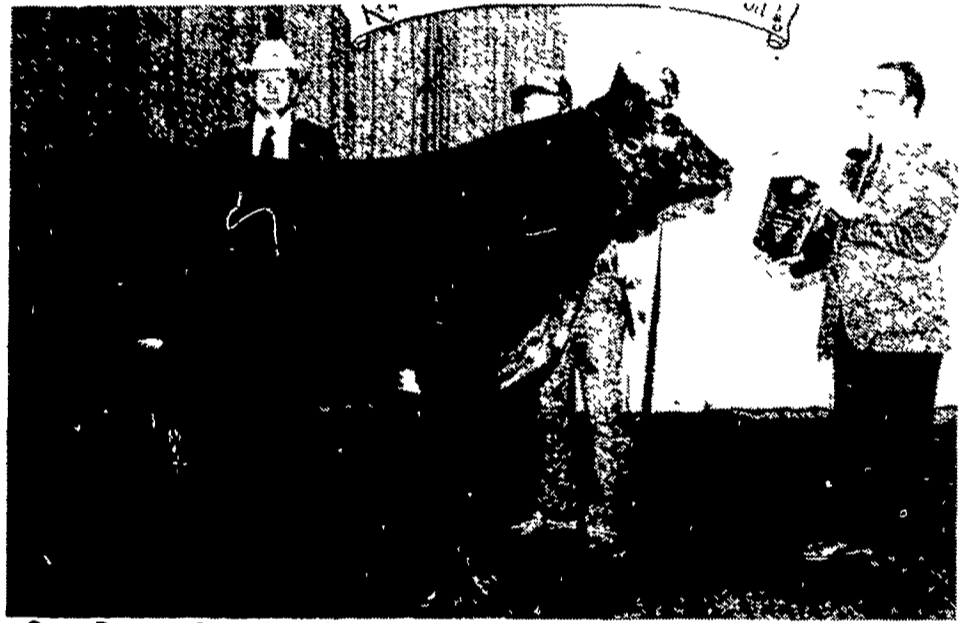

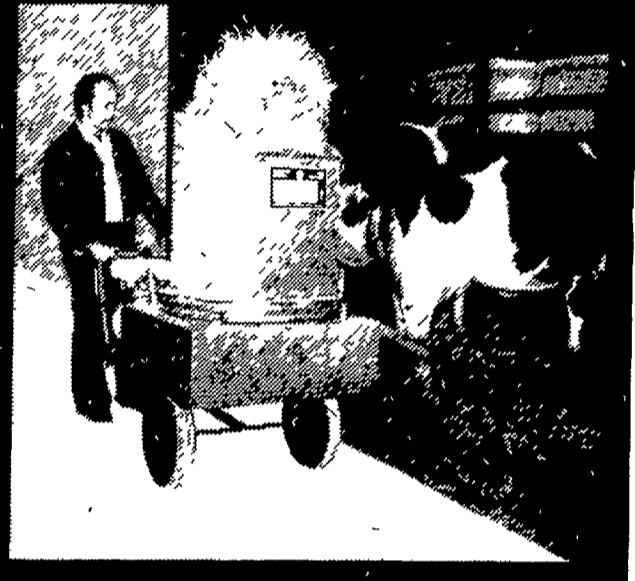

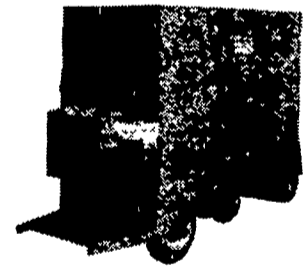
