

Pa. equines take champs at KILE

HARRISBURG — Last week's equine competition at the Keystone International Livestock Exposition held a record number of entries.

During the stiff competition, several Pennsylvania horsemen came out of the show arena leading champions in their respective breeds.

Bill Dickerson, New Hope, Bucks County, exhibited the grand champion Quarter Horse Stallion. His entry, Round Sir Frederic, was the first place three-year-old. The champ's sire is Sir Teddy Too and his dam is Blondie Sue.

In the Arabian Horse Show, the reserve champion mare, Wil-Or-El Garenza, was the first place three-

year-old exhibited by Wilfred E. Stevens, Bangor. The reserve champion gelding was shown by Carole Friendly of Macungie. Aazzy, a four-year-old stood second to the champion Arabian gelding in their class.

Don and Wende Swartz of Hummelstown, Dauphin County, exhibited the champion stallion during the Appaloosa Horse Show at KILE. The Swartz' champion was "Band Leader," winner of the four-year-old class.

"Story's Showgirl," a three-year-old mare, captured the grand champion Appaloosa mare title. The champion was exhibited by Wane J. Marmelo of Bethlehem, Nor-

thampton/Lehigh County. Reserve grand champion mare, "Brighter By Far," a two-year-old fillie, was shown by Barbara Linebach of Hummelstown, Dauphin County.

Reserve grand champion Appaloosa gelding went to "Banjo Bonanza," the second place four-year-old gelding. This entry was shown by Denny and Becky Bareis of Connoquenessing, Butler County.

A Clearfield County farm captured reserve champion honors in the 1980 Paint Horse Show. Crystal Garvin of Penfield, Clearfield County, showed the reserve grand champion stallion of the show. "Ton Dude," a two-year-old colt, was

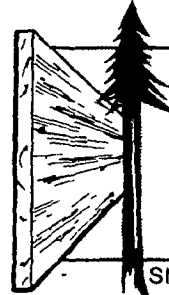
