Delaware 4-H to receive \$36,000 grant

WILMINGTON, Del. — The Delaware 4-H program has received a \$36,447 U.S. Department of Labor CETA

Fund grant to conduct a youth employment training project at Ferris School near Wilmington as part of a program to provide more employment opportunities for disadvantaged youth.

The grant was one of 124 given by the National Collaboration for Youth and its 13 member youth-serving organizations through a contract with the Office of Youth Programs of the U.S. Department of Labor. The grant was one of only seven made to 4-H programs nationwide.

The purpose of the outreach project is to strengthen community programs for youth employment through closer

cooperation with the primary local CETA sponsor.

The Delaware grant will support a 15-month employment training project at the Ferris School. The project will be administered by urban 4-H agent Mark Manno through the Delaware Cooperative Extension Service in cooperation with school administrators.

The 4-H Ferris Youth Agricultural Project will serve approximately 125 boys between the ages of 14-18. Those who enroll in it will receive practical vocational training in horticulture, woodworking, and general agriculture.

The project will be located exclusively at Ferris School and will focus on job placement for youths

preparing to enter the job market.

Besides receiving practical skills training, job counseling, and job placement, participants will be able to earn money for themselves as part of the program. Using a greenhouse on the grounds, for example, youth in the horticulture phase of the project will produce bedding plants and vegetables for sale to the public.

According to Manno, the project will rely heavily on volunteer leaders from 4-H,

the state's largest youth-serving organization.

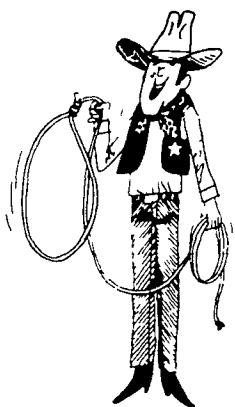
Although located at Ferris, the youth who will participate in the program came from all over Delaware. Currently 34 percent of the Ferris youth are from Wilmington, 33 percent from New Castle County, and 33 percent from Kent and Sussex counties.
