

This week is forest products week

SPRING GROVE — Trees are America's renewable resource. According to Thomas R. Wieland, tree farm family forester of the Glatfelter Pulp Wood Company, Spring Grove, the week of October 19-25 has been proclaimed National Forest Products Week.

In making the proclamation President Carter recognized the importance of forest products to our nation and the renewability of the forest, the basic resource, that provides these products.

The forest industries of southcentral Pennsylvania play an important role in the local economy. Thousands of jobs are provided by paper mills, sawmills, logging contractors and associated wood using industries. These businesses purchase much of the timber needed for their operations from local woodland owners thus providing additional income to the area economy.

As petroleum products become more expensive and difficult to obtain, wood will play an even greater role.

Today's forest yields lumber, fiber for paper, packaging products, fuel wood and much more.

Forest products are essential to everyday living and so is the proper management of our forests. Through sound forest practices the land can produce the necessary forest products and provide pure water, habitat for wildlife and a recreation haven for

an expanding population.

Woodland owners who desire assistance in the proper management techniques for their forestland can obtain it by contacting the nearest office of the Pennsylvania Bureau of Forestry, Thomas Wieland at Glatfelter in Spring Grove, or one of a number of consulting foresters who practice in the area.
