

Pa. Angus Assn. looks for 1981 queen

EAST BERLIN — The Pennsylvania Angus Association is looking for candidates for the title of 1981 Angus Queen, announced Helen F. Dixon.

To qualify for the title, she pointed out, the candidates must be between the ages of 15 and 19 and must be currently involved in raising Angus cattle, either breeding stock or steers. Daughters of Angus breeders, farm managers, or herdsmen also are eligible

to compete.

To enter the contest, each entry must be sponsored by a member in good standing of the Pennsylvania Angus Association, Dixon stated. She added if a potential contestant needs help in locating a sponsor, the state association would help find one for her.

Other criteria for the contest include:

—only two entries are permitted to represent each county;

—the Queen must agree to be present at the Pennsylvania Angus Spring Sale, Angus Field Day, Pennsylvania State Farm Show, and wherever she is needed to promote Angus cattle in the state.

Entries for the contest will be accepted until November 15, 1980. Each contestant should submit an autobiography along with a black and white photograph to be used in news releases.

The 1981 Pennsylvania

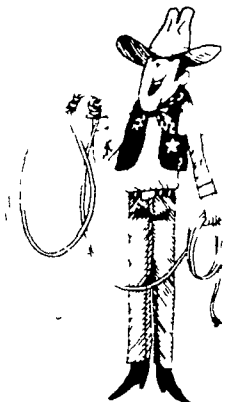
