Gun Control.

Proposes federal legislation to further regulate firearms, ban handguns—Promoted Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms regulation to register all firearms.

Locks up millions of hunting, fishing and trapping acres from public use—Carter Administration supports D-2 legislation, wilderness legislation that would lock out outdoorsmen from millions of acres of federal lands and water and places management of these lands within US Department of Interior

Proposes Weekend Boating and Fishing Restrictions.

Proposes restricting recreational boating on weekends in areas—Department of Energy is currently evaluating "emergency energy restrictions that would apply to all recreational vehicles and watercraft"

Opposes Reform of Gun Law.

Administration interpretation and enforcement of the Gun Control Act of 1968 has negatively impacted the constitutional rights of law-abiding gun owners and firearms dealers
