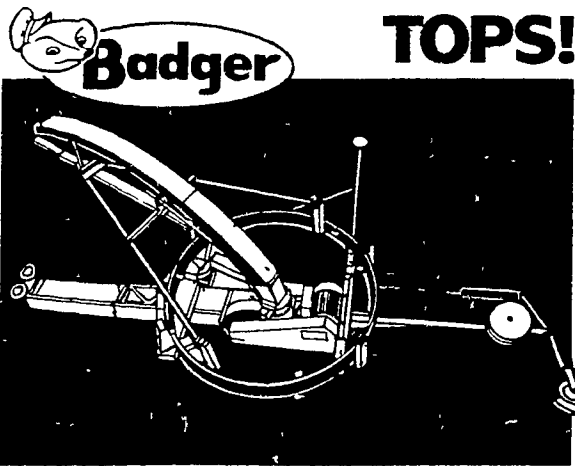

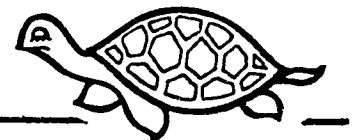
Cecil County reports top DHIA scores
