## Snowmobiles must be registered

HARRISBURG — Department of Environmental Resources Secretary Clifford L. Jones Friday reminded owners of snowmobiles that their vehicles must be registered with the department's Snowmobile Unit.

Each snowmobile must have a registration number and a valid registration decal displayed on the hood of the vehicle. The registration fee is \$10 for a two-year period.

Jones said a permanent registration number is assigned to each snowmobile by the Snowmobile Unit and the owner of the vehicle must display this number

with three-inch high reflective numbers. A validation decal, issued at the time of registration, must be attached to the right of the number.

All law enforcement officials, including state and local police, have the authority to enforce the snowmobile laws. In addition, designated DER employees are responsible for enforcing the law on state forest and state park lands.

Snowmobile registration information is available from licensed snowmobile dealers and DER's Snowmobile Unit, Box 1467, Harrisburg, PA 17120.
