Rogavan adds that it is not necessary to have a purebred dog to be in the club, just a desire to learn about dogs. The club will also explore career potentials in the canine world.

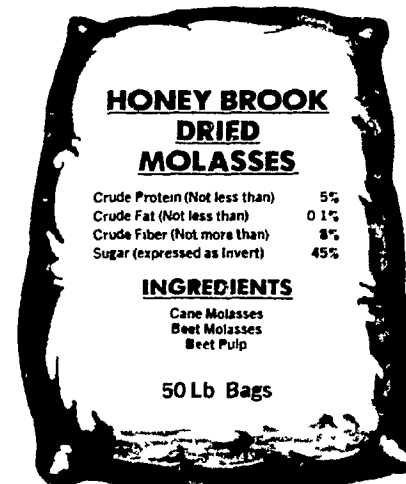
